Spring is finally here! And Summer is right around the corner!! When we say Summer at Giles County Public Library, our minds naturally go to Summer Reading! Jonah McCurry, Elizabeth Roller, and Susan Hickman have been working very hard to plan a great Summer Reading Program for all ages this summer. The overall theme for Summer Reading is "Libraries Rock" and each week will have sub-themes. You can pick up Summer Reading Passports at the library to log your reading starting the second week of May, get your passport stamped as you attend events, and as a reminder about all the activities each week.

The kick-off for Summer Reading is June 4th at First National Bank at 10:15am with Mr. Bond and the Science Guys. With this musical theme, Mr. Bond or Professor Greybeard will show the kids the "The Science of Sound." Another special event is planned for June 25th at First National Bank with Ryan Joseph and it's called "Is it a Violin or a Fiddle?" Ryan plays fiddle, mandolin, and does vocals with Alan Jackson and the Strayhorns. Bob Tarter and the Animal Symphony will also make a return appearance on June 29th at 10am at First National Bank. On Monday, July 9th, Summer Reading's Got Talent where the kids can attend at First National Bank and/or perform their talents! And our final special event will be the Rock' n Readin' Music Festival at the Gazebo. This is where the kids will turn in their reading logs and reap the rewards of participating and reading all summer!

Each week has fun activities for kids to do in addition to checking out books from the library and enjoying reading over the summer. Ms. Hickman will be having Summer Reading events at our Lynnville Branch of the library on Thursdays and several Fridays at our Elkton Branch. Don't forget to check out the Summer Reading Event calendar included in this newsletter, get signed up and don't miss the special events! We are also promoting Summer Reading for teens and adults with a challenge each week of a different book going along with the weekly themes.

Story times with Miss Elizabeth for the month of May are "Monkey

Business," "Mothers, Grandmothers, & Aunts," "Summer's Coming," and Stars & Stripes & Skies." Story times are on Friday mornings at 10:15am. During the Summer Reading Program, story times with Miss Elizabeth will be held on Mondays each week at 10:15am.

The next program in the "Living Well Series" will be on May 21st at 5:30 and the topic is "Preparing for Caregiving" with Brenda Speer.

Make sure to look at the calendars included to see what the World of Books and the Evening Book Clubs are reading over the summer. You may want to join. We will continue with the writer's group and bridge club during the summer. The beginning computer class will be taking a break in the month of June and will restart on July 24th at 8:45am. The intermediate computer class will be taking a break during June and July. Their first class back will be August 1st.

Robert Bailey's new book, *The Last Trial*, is coming out May 4th. *The Last Trial* is the third novel in the bestselling McMurtrie & Drake legal thriller series. Mr. Bailey will be at Giles County Public Library on June 5th at 5:30pm for an author event to talk about his new book! The first two novels, *The Professor* and *Between Black and White* both won the Beverly Hills Book Award for legal thriller of the year. He was very popular the last time he visited. So make plans for this event!

In August, we are starting a new DIY (do it yourself) series. We will be talking about growing and drying herbs with Alecia Allen. Our next Library Tea will also be held on August 31st.

As you can see, our summer calendar is full of great events. Mark your calendars and make plans to attend some or all!




