# Alexandria Delegates at the VEA Convention

### EAA Bylaws Revisions Approved!

The EAA Bylaws were recently revised and presented to the General Membership for review and approval by ballot. Ballots were received in the office, counted & verified by the Elections Credentials Committee and approved by EAA Board of Directors at their May 19th meeting.

There were 332 votes cast—329 in the positive and 3 in the negative. In order to be approved, two-thirds of those voting must vote in the positive. The revisions passed with a 99% approval rating. The EAA Board of Directors thanks the Bylaws Committee for their hard work.
