

Level 2: Intermediate Knitting: Fetching Fingerless Mittens

Want to learn how to expand your knitting skills and knit a stylish pair of fingerless mittens quickly? Fetching is knitted in the round with a cabled pattern at the wrist for holding the mitten in place and is finished with a simple picot edging. They are easy to learn and fun to make. They make excellent gifts for all occasions. So why not give it a try and let your imagination go wild with color selection.

Objectives:

To further build on your knitting skills by learning how to:

- Learn how to knit in the round
- Learn how to knit a cable and do a picot bind off
- Learn how to pick up stitches from waste yarn to finish the thumb
