

SAVE THE DATE FOR GREAT SOUTHEAST SHAKEOUT

Registration now open for Oct. 16 earthquake drill

RICHMOND, Va. – Virginians can practice "**Drop**, **Cover**, **and Hold On**," the safe response to an earthquake, during the Great SouthEast ShakeOut earthquake drill set for **Thursday**, **Oct. 16**, **at 10:16 a.m**.

Registration for the drill is open at <u>www.ReadyVirginia.gov</u> and also at <u>www.shakeout.org/southeast</u>. Those who register will receive information on how to plan their drill. These websites provide many resources for learning how to be prepared for an earthquake.

"ShakeOut is a great opportunity for all Virginians to quickly practice several steps that are potentially life-saving," said Jeff Stern, state coordinator for the Virginia Department of Emergency Management. "Most Virginians remember where they were when the 5.8 magnitude Mineral earthquake struck in August 2011. Participating in the Great SouthEast ShakeOut is a terrific training exercise for families, schools, businesses, organizations, government agencies, communities and individuals so that we all are more prepared for the next quake."

During the ShakeOut, people will practice these actions that are recommended when earthquakes occur:

- **Drop** to the ground where you are
- Take Cover under a sturdy table or desk if possible, protecting your head and neck
- Hold On until the shaking stops

Last year, more than one million Virginians took part in the *Great SouthEast ShakeOut*, a simultaneous earthquake drill held in the southeastern U.S. to coincide with drills held in other states and several countries, giving the effect of a rolling drill.

Coordinating partners for the *Great SouthEast ShakeOut* include the Central U.S. Earthquake Consortium and Federal Emergency Management Agency. ShakeOut originated in California, where statewide earthquake drills have been held annually since 2008, and has grown to be an international program with nearly 25 million people participating in 2013.

INFORMATION FROM OUR FIRE DEPARTMENT

The information below is from Captain II Bill Betz of the Fairfax County Fire & Rescue Department's Operation Bureau regarding the department's response to a house fire on Terrymill Drive in June:

I would like to thank you for taking the time to share your concerns in regards to the fire incident on Terrymill Drive and as it relates to fire apparatus response times to your neighborhood.

In relation to the fire incident on Terrymill Drive, the first unit to arrive was Engine 404 from the Herndon Fire Station on Spring Street which is the first fire apparatus due to the incident address. Engine 404 arrived on scene 6 minutes and 22 seconds after the dispatch of the incident with several other units arriving shortly thereafter. Engine 412 from the Great Falls Fire Station was dispatched on the event as a support unit after several fire units were on scene working to extinguish the fire and perform other fire ground duties.

There are many factors that determine which fire department apparatus responds to an incident and the department uses a GPS tracking system to ensure the closest units respond to events of any and all types. This ensures we have emergency personnel on the scene of an emergency as soon as possible, as was the case with the event on Terrymill Drive.

The Herndon Fire Station is the primary company that responds to incidents in your neighborhood. If they are out on an event and/or additional units need to respond to your neighborhood, then residents could expect apparatus to respond from North Point Fire Station #39 on Reston Avenue, Sterling Park Fire Department from Loudoun County, Reston Fire Station #25 on Wiehle Avenue , and Fox Mill Fire Station #31 on Reston Parkway. These are the closest stations in proximity to your neighborhood and are all within a 10 minute response to your location.

The mission of the Fire and Rescue Department is to be a premier community focused Fire and Rescue Department ensuring a safe environment for our community.
