

Student Agreement Forms

Listed below are the **Permission to Participate in Senior DECATS Form, the Behavior Contract Form, Field Trip Permission Form, Transportation Form, Acceptable Use Policy Form, Photo Release Form, and the Emergency Contact and Medical Information Form** for participation in Senior DECATS Program. The general guidelines are provided below and have been condensed into one form for convenience.

General Release for Participation in Senior DECATS Program

I give permission for my child to participate in activities in the Senior DECATS program. I release the DeBusk Enrichment Center for Academically Talented Students, the Diocese of Dallas, Bishop Lynch High School and the employees and their families from liability or responsibility regarding participation in the program. I will not sue the DeBusk Enrichment Center for Academically Talented Students, the Diocese of Dallas, Bishop Lynch High School and the employees and their families for any expenses, damages or losses arising from the participation in activities and field trips associated with the Senior DECATS program.

Please complete and print out only the Emergency Contact and Medical Information Form (page 3). On the bottom of the form you will find a place to initial that you have read and understand all the forms including the General Release Waiver outlined above. Please return this form to Senior DECATS on the first day of Senior DECATS. The Student Agreement Forms may also be found online (www.srdecats.org).

Behavior Contract

(Read and initial the bottom of the last page)

As a student with the Senior DEATS Summer Program, I agree to:

- be responsible for my behavior.
- act in a mature and kind manner to all students and adults that I interact with during the Senior DECATS program.
- be respectful in my language, mannerisms and behavior toward all people in the program.
- be respectful on all field trips.
- be respectful of the property of others.
- be respectful of the property of school(s) – classrooms, gyms, classroom materials, books, and equipment.
- be respectful of the property of all members of the community

I understand that if I fail to live up to these standards, I will receive a maximum of two warnings (“strikes”). If for any reason, I receive a third warning (“strike”), I will be asked to call my parents, leave the program and not return – no refunds for any tuition paid. I understand that the staff of the program is to treat me with respect and care, and that if someone is not treating me in a fair and just manner, I will report their behavior to one of the administrators (Mrs. Shotland or Mr. Solomon).

Field Trip and Transportation Permission

(Read and initial the bottom of the last page)

I understand that there are activities within the program that are a part of the learning experience that may involve transporting my child off the premises. I understand that field trip drivers are licensed, professional drivers employed by Bishop Lynch. I understand that reasonable and necessary precautions will be taken regarding my child’s welfare and recognize that the staff will take routine measures to provide supervision. I release the program, staff and administrators of the program as well as the host school and the Diocese of Dallas from all liability regarding these field trips.

I release DeBusk Enrichment Center for Academically Talented Students, Bishop Lynch, the Diocese of Dallas, Senior DECATS and their employees/families from any liability or responsibility regarding this transportation.

Photo Release Form

(Read and initial the bottom of the last page)

I hereby consent to and authorize the use and reproduction of all photographs and other audiovisual materials taken of my son\daughter during the 2019 Senior DECATS program for the sole use of promotional material, educational activities, exhibitions, or for any other use for the benefit of the program. I also consent to the use of any photos or videos of my child to be used on the DeBusk Foundation website.

Student Acceptable Use Policy

(Read and initial the bottom of the last page)

Access to technology and the Internet is a privilege, which brings with it a number of responsibilities. In order to use the technology services available at the host school, you must read the following information and sign the agreement that follows.

- The school network is intended for the exclusive use of its registered users. As a user, you are responsible for the use of your account. Any problems that arise from the user's account are the responsibility of the account holder. Any misuse will result in suspension of the account privileges.
- The use of technology and the Internet is a privilege that may be revoked by faculty/staff, or administrators at any time for abusive or inappropriate conduct. Such conduct would include, but not limited to: accessing another person's files or email to examine, delete, copy, or modify files/data; accessing or viewing obscene, abusive, or otherwise objectionable language or images in either public or private files/messages; attempting to alter system software or hardware configurations; harassment of any sort; malicious, intentional, or willful behavior to degrade system performance or capability.
- Posting unkind, inappropriate or untrue information about another student or person in the community on any social media available for Senior DECATS students and families. Bullying will not be tolerated under any conditions, from any location and at any time (including before and after the program start and end dates). Senior DECATS follows all social media policies set forth by the Diocese of Dallas.
- While we take every precaution to make sure students are on appropriate sites, no software is foolproof. A user who accidentally connects to an inappropriate site must immediately disconnect from the site and notify a teacher or supervisor. If a user sees another user accessing inappropriate sites, he or she should notify a teacher or supervisor immediately.
- Internet access is available which will provide educational resources worldwide. Student Internet access may be limited to a specific time allotment.
- Commercial software is placed on the computer for the use and convenience of students, faculty/staff, and administration. Any unlawful use such as the copying of copyright material without the express written permission of the company or proper licensure is prohibited.
