






## A New Century of Hospice Care

Hospice is a program of care and support for a person diagnosed with a terminal illness and where comfort care is desired. Helping people find meaning and peace is at the core of our mission.

At **New Century Hospice**, our program supports early involvement where a dramatic difference in the quality of life can be experienced. By enabling families and loved ones to participate in the care experience, we are able to make the remaining time more meaningful, dignified and comfortable.



## Who is Eligible for Hospice Care?

Hospice care is for people who have a life expectancy of six months or less and have chosen to focus on palliative care, comfort, and relief from pain and symptoms.

Diagnoses commonly associated with hospice care are cancer and other end-stage illness such as:

- · Cardiovascular Disease
- Alzheimer's Disease
- · Respiratory Disease
- respiratory Discuss
- · Liver/Renal Disease
- · Pulmonary Disease
- · AIDS/HIV
- · Neurological Disease
- · Stroke or Coma
- ALS (Lou Gehrig's Disease)

No one is denied service because of age, race, color, creed, gender, national origin, sexual orientation, religion, disability, diagnosis or the ability to pay.

### General Guidelines:

Hospice appropriate individuals may exhibit some or all of the following:

- · Uncontrolled or increased pain
- · Frequent hospitalizations
- · Progressive weight loss
- · Recurrent infections
- · Decline in functional status
- · Deteriorating mental abilities
- · Multiple decubitis ulcers
- · Increased breathing difficulties

## Who Pays for Hospice Care?

The Medicare Hospice Benefit covers the cost of New Century Hospice care. Coverage is also available through other private insurance companies. Plans cover all hospice care services, medications, supplies and equipment related to the hospice diagnosis with usually no out-of-pocket expenses to the patient.

The hospice benefit is not limited in length of time. Early referrals help patients and their families access and receive the full spectrum of **New Century Hospice** services.


# What Makes New Century Hospice Different?
