Professor Robert Korody, Rokudan, is a certified instructor of the Pacific Jujitsu Alliance under Professor Robert McKean and currently teaches and trains in NYC. Professor Korody began his training in Danzan Ryu Jujitsu under Professor Gerald Halligan in 1991 and has also made a comprehensive study of the Danzan Ryu healing arts curriculum of massage and seifukujitsu.

Professor Korody also holds the rank of Yodan, or 4th degree black belt, with the American Judo and Jujitsu Federation, a sister organization of DZR, and is also an advanced instructor of Combat Knife Fighting under the Concrete Warrior Knife Society, an affiliate of the Pacific Jujitsu Alliance. He also holds the rank of 4th sash in Wu Yin Yan Jing Kung Fu, a fighting system of Kung Fu and teaches extensive blocking, striking, and kicking technique in conjunction with the Danzan Ryu Jujitsu curriculum.

Professor Korody is the director and chief instructor of the Pacific Jujitsu Alliance healing arts curriculum and has been a practitioner of Okazaki restorative massage and Seifukujitsu for many years. Professor Korody is a NYS licensed Physical Therapist and Acupuncturist, and the owner and chief practitioner of Cedar Mountain Healing Arts of NYC. Professor Korody also serves as an Auxiliary Sergeant with the New York City Police Department.

Professor Korody was awarded the title of Danzan Ryu Professor by the Pacific Jujitsu Alliance at *Ohana 2016* in Sparks, NV.
