

Plein Air Pottery Camp 2020 at EK Studio!

RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

My child, _____ (“Participant”), will participate and I/we

_____ (“Parent”) give permission for Participant to participate in

the Plein Air Pottery Camp at EK Studios on Buddy’s Farm (420 Ponderosa Trail, Dallas, Georgia). While

participating in Camp, Participant will completing various clay projects outdoors under the instruction of Ms.

Emily, Ms. Audrey, and Ms. Lauren.

Parent’s agreement to allow Participant to participate in the Camp Activities is entirely voluntary. Parent is the duly authorized guardian or parent of Participant and has full and exclusive authority to make the agreements contained herein.

COVID-19 Information and Acknowledgement of Risk: Participant and Parent (collectively “we”) understand that the Activity involves certain risks, hazards and conditions. During the COVID-19 Pandemic (SARS-CoV-2), Georgia Governor Brian Kemp has ordered on May 12th, 2020 the following guidelines for Summer Camps that EK Studio will follow. All participants, guardians, and employees are expected to follow suit with these guidelines. 1. Reading and acknowledging signage at the entrance to instruct Camper’s that they cannot enter if they have previously or currently been diagnosed with COVID-19, have exhibited symptoms of COVID-19 at any time or have had contact with a person that has or is suspected to have COVID-19.
2. Reading and acknowledging signage regarding sanitation procedures, social distancing requirements, and other instructions.
3. Screening all campers at drop-off and preventing any camper from entering that exhibits a temperature greater than 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit, cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, other respiratory symptoms, or at least two of the following symptoms: chills, repeated shaking or chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell.
4. Requiring that any persons exhibiting the following symptoms at any time: chills, repeated shaking or chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell; will be separated immediately from the group and must leave the camp facility as soon as practicable.
5. Any worker or camper who has stayed home sick at any point during the week of camp will not be permitted to return again until they have either had a negative COVID-19 test or have been fever free for at least 72 hours and must wait 10 days before returning to camp. Since these camps are weekly, if the student leaves with any fever or symptoms of coronavirus, the camper will not be allowed to return to EK Studio during the week they are out sick.
6. Requiring parents dropping off and picking up to remain in their vehicles
7. Utilizing contactless forms of camper check-in and check-out
8. Implementing staggered drop off and pick up times as practicable
9. Providing hand sanitizer as soon as possible upon drop off
10. Prohibiting unnecessary visitors to camp activities and facilities
11. Limiting indoor activity and/or tours unless needed for bathroom breaks. The restroom will be in a camper on the EK studio property and an outdoor sink will be utilized
12. Providing training to workers on how to identify symptoms of illness in camper and the proper processes for removing a potentially ill camper
13. Providing an isolation area for any sick camper until parent has picked up
14. Limiting groups under 20 individuals

- 15. Keeping the same workers and campers in the same groups to the extent possible
- 16. Enforcing social distancing and prohibiting congregating among campers belonging to different groups
- 17. Providing a separate designated space for each camper to store personal belongings
- 18. Prohibiting use of camp facilities and equipment that are not able to be regularly sanitized
- 19. Allowing only one group to use camp equipment at a time
- 20. Sanitizing camp equipment after each group use
- 21. Requiring workers to patrol camp areas to enforce sanitation policies
- 22. Swimming policy (Not Applicable)
- 23. Prohibiting contact between campers and other patrons if necessary
- 24. Providing sanitizer stations and requiring regular use
- 25. Requiring campers to wash and/or sanitize between bathroom breaks
- 26. Requiring campers to bring their own lunch and snacks with them to camp each day with all items labeled with the campers first and last name
- 27. Requiring social distancing for any dining area
- 28. Requiring workers to wear gloves when helping campers open food items for meals and snacks
- 29. Camp vehicles policy (Not Applicable)
- 30. Requiring workers to clean and sanitize bathrooms and frequently touched surfaces regularly
- 31. Providing masks or other PPE to workers when necessary within the camp facility
- 32. Providing masks or other PPE to campers when necessary within the camp facility
- 33. Overnight summer camps (Not Applicable)

Medical Release: Participant is not suffering from any medical condition, impairment, or disease that would prevent his/her safe participation in the Activity. We have disclosed any and all of Participant’s medical conditions to the administrators of the Activity (See “Allergies and Medical Conditions page). We acknowledge that Participant is physically fit and mentally capable of participating in all Camp activities. Participant has not been advised by a physician or any other health care provider to limit his or her participation in activities such as the Activity. Participant and Parent assume responsibility for Participant’s participation in the Activity and injury while participating in the Activity. We understand that EK Studio may not have medical personnel available at the location of the Activity. We therefore grant EK Studio permission to authorize emergency medical treatment, if deemed necessary by staff. We agree that EK Studio assumes no responsibility or liability for any injury or damage that might arise out of or in connection with such authorized medical treatment. EK Studio is not responsible to provide for and pay for any medical costs that we may incur during or arising from Participant’s voluntary participation in this activity, unless deemed at the complete intentional fault of EK studio and staff.
