WINNERS OF EARLY BIRD DRAWINGS

The first 2 winners of cash prizes offered as incentive to get out the vote in APWU elections have been chosen. Michelle Petrillo (Tour 3 – Clerk) and Dennis McCue (Tour 1 – Maintenance) were the winners of \$100 each based on a random drawing. This drawing was offered in order to minimize lost ballots and the need for ordering duplicate ballots by getting them in as soon as they were received. To date, we have received 161 out of a possible 374 ballots. That equates to 43% of our eligible members voting thus far. It is a good start, but there are still 57% of our members that we need to complete their ballot before the final deadline of October 3rd at noon. There will be an additional \$400 in prizes awarded to names drawn from among all eligible voters (8 prizes of \$50 each). Everyone that was eligible for the early bird drawing is still eligible for the remaining prizes. All of the rest still have time to vote. Bring your ballot in and show the completed, sealed ballot to any officer or steward before you mail it and you will be entered into the remaining drawings. If you did not receive, lost, trashed or otherwise do not have a ballot, stop by the union office ASAP to request a duplicate. The new ballot will be mailed to your house.
