

**For: High School Age youth and accompanying adult advisors.** (Entering freshmen through graduated seniors; adult advisors must be 21 yrs+)

**Fee: \$555.00/per youth:** (Registration fee includes all programming, food, & lodging. Everything but travel to the event). The intent is for this cost to decrease a result of presbytery-wide fund raisers. Check the presbytery website by the end of February for the updated cost. **Scholarships will also be available.**

Every three years high school age students from the Presbyterian Church (USA) and the Cumberland Presbyterian Church gather together at Purdue University. Youth from all churches (across the sponsoring denominations) come together for this life changing, life giving, faith growing gathering!
