I am looking forward to all of the events the Aerie has planned for us this year.

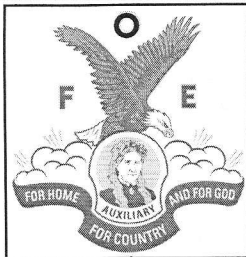

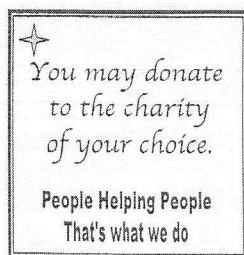
