Kids' Stuff COVID Closure Update June 30, 2020

Kids' Stuff has received notice of another positive COVID result. We strongly encourage family units as well as staff members to be tested. We understand this is a difficult process and a choice. Symptomatic and asymptomatic situations are being ruled due to diligent testing. Many tests are reporting back to me negative and thank you for passing your results along. This has helped us and the Health Department trace and plan.

In consideration of all of our family and staff 's health and well-being, in compliance with CDC and recommendation of the Health Department

We have extended our closure at Kids' Stuff for a total two (2) weeks.

Kids' Stuff will Re-Open on Monday July 13.

You will continue to be notified with Information updates via email and website. All informational letters and information updates are posted on our website <u>www.kidsstufftlc.com</u>. Please check our website regularly.

We feel confident in our decision. Our continued discussions with the Pasco County Health Department and in accordance with the CDC guidelines, a closure of 16 days will represent a full quarantine of 14 days. The school buildings have been deep cleaned and sanitized. We have been directed to reopen on July 13th and go forward with strict entry procedures as well as practicing social distancing as much as possible and consistent hand washing and hygiene. We continue to sanitize indoor and outdoor with a 10 minute set time of sanitizing element.

Upon re-opening on Monday July 13, 2020 you will experience the following arrival and departure methods. This is now our protocol.

- 1. All Adults, Staff and Family must wear a mask or shield upon entry.
- 2. Each Family will be required to complete a brief questionnaire about your contacts and travels during the 16 days of closure.
- 3. Each Adult/Child will have their temperature recorded upon entry. This effort has helped pre-screen.
- 4. Students of preschool and early elementary age are suggested to, but not required to wear coverings at this time. This will be a choice for the parent. At your request we will certainly encourage the child to wear the mask if over the age of 2.
- Staff will be required to wear a mask/shield when indoors and in smaller group settings when social distancing cannot be practiced.

6. No computer check in and out will be required as we continue to take manual attendance.

Billing has been suspended and your accounts will only be billed for your time attended week of June 22 – June 26. Billing will resume July 13, 2020.

Thank you for your patience in supporting our quarantine 14-day process. If you are sick, get tested and quarantine. Limit family & friend exposure. Allowing our families and staff time to wait out any testing results is most important right now.
