

**City of Pillager
City Council Meeting Minutes
March 13, 2018**

Mayor Mattheisen called the regular meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. with the pledge of allegiance being said. Council Members present were, Ann Meyer, Leroy Smith, Clarence Voitalla, absent was Gary Greenheck. Guest at the meeting was Norman Rohl, Donna Klimek, Shayne and Louise Johnson, Tod Gardner and guest, staff present was Jan Loftis.

Shayne and Louise Johnson requested permission to build a deep winter green house and a packing and washing shed on their property. They would like to put in a sand point for this project. A building permit will be required. **Motion by Council Smith to allow one well for watering purposes only to be installed contingent on what our ordinance says, seconded by Council Voitalla, motion carried unanimously.**

The minutes and expenses were discussed. **Motion by Council Meyer to approve the minutes and expenses as presented, seconded by Council Voitalla, motion carried unanimously.**

Visitor Forum:

Donna Klimek from the Pillager Fair Board was here to ask permission to do a raffle at the Fiddler's Contest on April 7th 2018 and approval for a liquor Licenses at the Pillager Fair July 13 & 14. The fair will be July 12-15.

Motion by Council Smith to approve the Raffle for April 7th at the Fiddlers Contest, seconded by Council Ann Meyer, motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Council Smith to approve the liquor license for the Beer Garden at the Pillager Fair on Friday 13th and Saturday 14th 2018, seconded by Council Voitalla, motion carried unanimously.

Old Business:

Mr. Gardner was here to update Council on the progress of his car lot. He is still waiting to get the water lines in and for the state licenses. He asked permission to move cars to the lot before he has it done to save money on storage. He request was declined. Council stated per our ordinance this will not be possible.

The water meter the City had tested last month for a resident tested out fine.

New Business:




