We have partnered with colleges, non-profit organizations and local businesses to provide underserved youth opportunities to develop career skills for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century. This mentorship program will give students encouragement to create an attainable path for their future goals. Please keep reading to find out how you can help.

#### **LifeBridge Core Principals:**

1. Helping students develop their postsecondary and career goals by ***fostering the connection between academic success and career aspirations***.
2. Meeting the challenges of adolescence and young adulthood through ***mentoring activities that reinforce the schools' core values***.
3. Facilitating conversations and engaging students in activities ***focused on critical thinking and problem solving***, decision making, goal setting, etc.
4. ***Ensuring that students know how to thrive in both good and challenging times*** by holding themselves to high expectations, living up to the core values, staying focused on achieving their goals and overcoming adversity.
5. ***Inspiring students to develop resolute hope***, leading to a positive transformation because of the opportunities in their future.

**You Could Be The Mentor We're Looking For:** **LifeBridge Mentoring Program** is looking for adult professionals to volunteer their time and energy, mentoring underserved youth, aged 16 to 23 years old, one-on-one and in groups. You can choose to mentor in-person, by phone or via the internet.

You must be willing to commit to at least an hour per week of one-to-one mentoring for 20-25 weeks during the coming school year. In addition, if selected as a mentor, you will also be required to adhere to the following:

- Undergo a background check (at no cost to you);
- Attend a mentoring orientation and participate in two hours of mentor training;
- Be committed to serving the entire duration of the program; and
- Be open to attending special events and group classes.

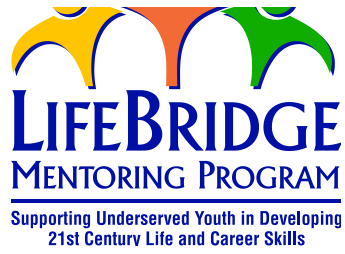
