

The Point is: Do we listen? We cannot blame God for a lack of guidance. The Church reapplies Psalm 65 to stress this: "You [God] have visited the land and watered it [with your word]; greatly have you enriched it" (Responsorial Psalm).

2nd Reading Rom 8:18-23 [Future Redemption of the Body]

Paul offers his attitude toward the created world. God made the world, hence it must be good. Nevertheless, it is in slavery to corruption because of Adam's [every human being's] sin. As part of the created world humans groan too. But there is hope of liberation. We expect a new heaven and a new world. Redeemed humanity will live in peace with God in a world transformed by his Spirit.



THEME: The Word of God

A word, be it spoken or written, always has something to do with the person who speaks or writes. There is power and inspiration in a human word and through it we feel contact with a living person. The same can be said of the word of God. As the great Hebrew poet Isaiah says, it never returns "void" (First Reading) but is always fertile. The power of God's word is like the germinal force of the seed, which makes us hope for fruit and harvest. Today's Scripture reading tells us about God's word, what can and should happen to it when it is spoken to human beings, to you and to me. Various kinds of people hear God's word, but the harvest (the results of that living contact through his word) are not the same in all people. Where do you classify yourself? "The seed is the word of God, Christ is the sower. All who come to him have life for ever" (Gospel Acclamation).
