Dear Sir:

As you are surely aware, I am the Petitioner in the RICO matter see, *Purpura v. Christie*, et al., now before the District Court 15-cv-03534. You may not know however that I have been forced to file another Motion, a Writ of Mandamus, with the 3rd Circuit Court relating to questionable activities and probable collusion between the Defense Attorneys and the District Court's personnel.

I am reaching out to you on this day in friendship and it is a sincere desire that you accept this outreach for what it is. To be clear sir, when this Petition was instituted almost a year ago, I was convinced that you were a part of the political cabal here in New Jersey, those trying to destroy the Second Amendment. When you or your office failed to respond to last year's letter I wrote to you concerning the possible use of "Executive Action" in regards to helping to remove some of the most egregious gun laws, I had no recourse but to include you in the lawsuit.

Recently however, do to not just some very strong and encouraging statements you have made, but your latest vetoes of S3146/A3773 and S3416/A4808, it appears that you may actually be a friend of the Second Amendment. I pray this to be so.

It is possible that some of these actions are related to your running for office and they do not really reside deeply in your beliefs. As I am sure you have heard that thousands of law abiding citizens, after hearing your remarks in this past debate about how you have made it easier to get a carry permit, were disappointed as they were informed by their various Police Chiefs that no changes to the laws have been made. So if indeed you have something in the works that will do as you said, fantastic.

If there is no such mechanism moving through the system, you now have a huge opportunity to begin that process. Again I reference my Petition. At this moment, your government officials are pulling every trick in the book to have it dismissed. If you are not familiar with the lawsuit, please understand that it does not ask for penalties, removals from office or compensation. It only asks that unconstitutional gun laws here in NJ, be reviewed and if found to be so, removed or altered. The other is that no further unconstitutional legislation take place here in New Jersey.

What better way could there possibly be to strengthen your position with conservative voters, across this country, than to hold a press conference and announce that your administration will no longer use tax payer dollars in defense of New Jersey's ongoing effort to destroy the 2nd Amendment?

There may be other actions or agreements that could be worked out which would be beneficial to not just your campaign, but to the citizens of New Jersey. I believe together, privately, we can put an end to these legal actions now pending and thereby curtail any possible embarrassment of New Jersey officials or judges and too, convince many sceptics as to your credibility concerning the Second Amendment.

Believe me Governor, this current legal action is just the tip of the iceberg. If the District Court is foolish enough to violate the Constitution, Federal Rules of Civil Procedure as well as the Judicial Code of Conduct in the issuance of faulty dismissals, all of those involved in that will be held to account in the appeals process.

Please take very seriously my request here to sit down with you in a private meeting. I understand that you are very busy running the affairs of the state and also running for President. While a short less than a half hour meeting with you may not help your relationship with those ideological leftists in New Jersey government, it will absolutely boost your standing with conservative voters across this wonderful country.

If we can privately meet, I believe you will be pleasantly surprised. In spite of what you may think, it is not my purpose to denigrate any of the defendants named in this lawsuit. That goes especially for you Governor.
