SERMON TITLE: **NEW BEGINNINGS**

PSALM 95:1-3; 6-7

We love and worship God because of who He is and what He has done.

CONTEXT: PSALMS 95:1-3; 6-7

Come, let us sing for joy to the Lord;

let us shout aloud to the Rock of our salvation.

² Let us come before him with thanksgiving and extol him with music and song.
WHY?

WHY? BECAUSE

³ For the Lord is the great God, the great King above all gods.

⁶ Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the Lord our Maker;

⁷ for he is our God and we are the people of his pasture, the flock under his care.

Throughout the Bible and our journey of faith, we see and experience God's mighty hand that leads us through the wilderness of life and offers us opportunities for NEW BEGINNINGS.

God lead and kept the Israelites of the Exodus through their years in the wilderness. And, then we read in Joshua 3-4 how God then led them across the Jordan River and into a time of NEW BEGINNINGS in the "Promised Land."

Likewise, I believe, God has lead us and helped us through a year of COVID, which has seemed like a time in the wilderness. I believe that today, we are turning the corner and like the people of Israel, we are preparing to cross our Jordan River and enter into a time of NEW BEGINNINGS.

As God directed Joshua and the people to make a memorial of rocks so that they would remember God's care – we too will make a symbolic memorial of rocks – by laying our past before the cross of Jesus – we lay down our wilderness and look forward to a NEW BEGINNING.

In all of this, we begin and end today's service worshipping GOD WHO HAS KEPT US, IS KEEPING US, and WILL LEAD US FORWARD IN THE DAYS TO COME TO A NEW BEGINNING.
