## **ITALIAN COURSES:**

INTRODUCTION TO ITALIAN

8-week session - \$100

Wednesday 6:00pm - 7:00pm

Instructor: Daniela Ciccone

This is an introductory course designed for people who have no prior knowledge of Italian.

Topics will include: pronunciation, greetings, days, dates, numbers, time, expressing personal information and an introduction to basic grammar concepts.

This course does not require a textbook.

Class dates: October 23, 30, November 6, 13, 20, December 4, 11, 18 (No class on November 27th!)

ITALIAN BEGINNER 1

8-week session - \$100 Wednesday 7:00pm - 8:00pm

Instructor: Daniela Ciccone

This course is designed for students who were enrolled in the Introduction to Italian class in Fall Session 1 (Wed 7:00) or anyone who has some knowledge of basic Italian and does not need an introductory course.

Topics will include: food vocabulary, dialogues and expressions related to food and eating out, and present tense verbs in order to facilitate conversation.

This course does not require a textbook.

ITALIAN BEGINNER 2
