We have received payment from Geico Insurance for the vehicle that damaged our irrigation system at our Triangle Park. AJ's Pump & Sprinkler (they installed the system) will repair it for us so we can turn the water on at our park again. As soon as it cools down a group of HBPOA members will tackle the trimming and weeding of the plants in the Triangle Park. Hurricane Irma blew our little Cassia Trees over; however, we were able to right them again and stake them upright, they seem to be okay so far.

The county has not done anything further towards repairing the water leak at our Dolphin Fountain at US Highway 19 as they have been dealing with cleanup from the flooding of the Withlacoochee River in the east side of Hernando County. Cal Holland and myself have started the weeding again there and Tim Goodman has volunteered to mow it. Thank you, Tim we appreciate your doing that for our Hernando Beach community.

## **MINUTES OF THE HBPOA MEETING, October 5, 2017, Coast Guard Station**

The monthly meeting of the HBPOA was called to order at 7:05 PM by Gladys Moore, President, who proceeded to lead those present in the Pledge of Allegiance. Subsequently, the meeting was turned over to Kathy Frase who introduced our guest speaker for the evening, Will Van Gelder of the Southwest Florida Water Management District.

Mr. Van Gelder began his presentation with some background information on his education, which was noteworthy, and also made the point early on that he is very interested in preservation of our water resources. He stated that he currently manages upland water systems after having worked with wetlands in the past and emphasized that good healthy upland systems are instrumental in maintaining healthy wetlands which are crucial, not only for the health of our coastal communities and maintaining our natural resources but also for economic growth and health of our communities and state. Before getting into his actual presentation, he emphasized that he

wanted questions from the audience as they arose because he was there to serve us, not the opposite.

He mentioned the challenges/difficulties that have been placed on the state's resources including the water management by the fires which preceded the hurricanes that hit our state, wreaking havoc in many areas of our state. It was interesting to hear that there are 5 district lands set aside all over the state which in essence serve as biological filtration systems, thus helping to maintain the health of our water resources. Another salient point was the mission of the water management districts: 1) To protect water resources; 2) To minimize flood risk; and 3) To insure that public water needs are met. Their responsibility for water quality, water quantity and natural system protection is taken very seriously.

It was truly fascinating to become informed about the practice of prescribed burning by the water district with a target of 40,000 acres per year which can vary widely depending upon the incidence of wild fires in any given year. The purpose and benefit of such controlled burning is to

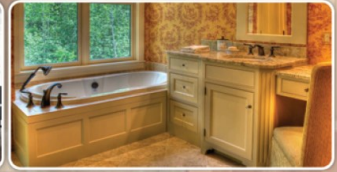
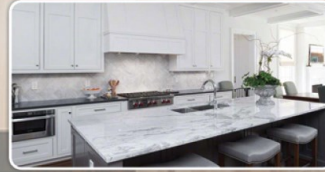

reduce evaporation and transference of rainfall since 90% of the water produced is lost to those, thus leaving only 10% for infiltration. This process is crucial to our water supply, by producing more water that is cleaner. A burn can reduce the first two named processes to 70 to 80% which increases the infiltration process to 20-30%, a significant positive outcome.

A number of questions/comments were entertained by Mr. Van Gelder which he answered to the best of his ability. It all contributed to a lively discussion and a very informative presentation.

After our speaker was properly thanked, Gladys once again called upon Kathy Frase to conduct the volunteer appreciation ceremony during which she recognized so many of the volunteers who give so much to our community. A highlight of this presentation was the recognition of Steve Krou, Dan Garrett, and Diane Liptake who worked so diligently and with such artistic talent on the murals which were painted upon the four garage doors of our local fire department. Diane Greenwell presented each of the three with a collage of the paintings themselves and of the process as well. Additionally a collage was presented to Kathy Frase to thank her for all the support she contributed to the project.

The business part of the evening's meeting was resumed with Gladys' calling for a motion to accept the September minutes as published in

the October Beachcomber. Betty McQuire so moved and Benny Martinez seconded the motion which carried unanimously.

In Margo McConnell's absence, Gladys Moore gave the treasurer's report as follows: Balance on Hand as of 9/30/17 for the HBPOA General Account was \$13,906.72 and the Balance on Hand as 9/30/17 for the HBPOA Entranceway Account was \$3,040.55. The report was accepted as factual and will be filed for audit.

### COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Publicity/Beachcomber...For Jen Brown, Gladys reminded us that the cutoff date for submission of articles/information for the Beachcomber remains, as always, the 10<sup>th</sup> of each preceding month. She also invited all attendees to view the photo contest entries on the laptop on a back table and to then vote for their favorite photo.

Landscaping...Gladys gave updates on the leak in/under the fountain at US 19. This leak had increased our utilities there significantly until it was detected and the fountain was shut off. She also reported on the repair of the damage to the Triangle for which insurance money has been forthcoming.

Hospitality.....Kathy Frase shared that there have been 48 new residents in Hernando Beach so far this year, 27 of whom received welcome bags. She introduced our new guests: Ron and Glenda

### **WEEKI WACHEE ROGERS PARK LID IMPLEMENTATION**

#### **Project Overview**

The Southwest Florida Water Management District and Hernando County will be making enhancements to stormwater management at Rogers Park. The park is owned by the County and located on the Weeki Wachee River. These improvements will benefit the river by reducing the amount of sediments and nutrients entering the river.

#### **Project Details**

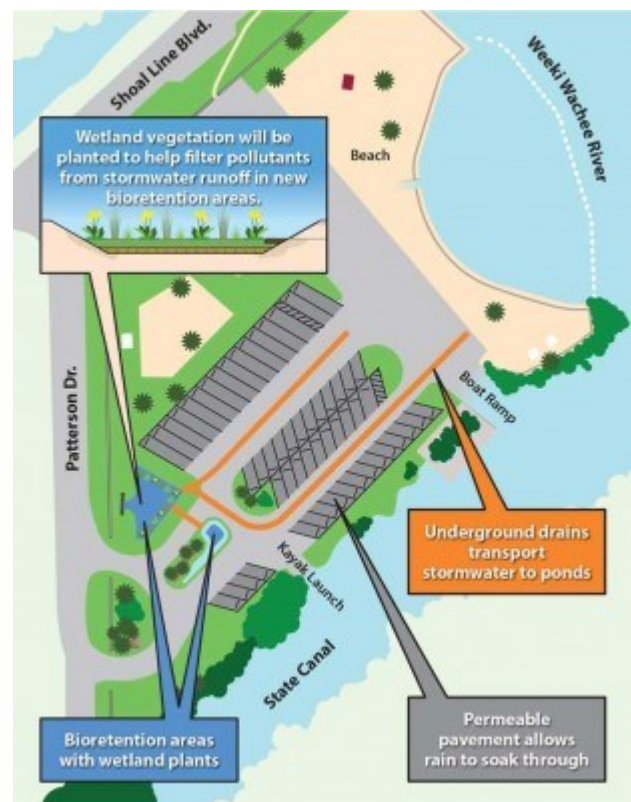
This project uses Low Impact Development (LID) techniques to treat stormwater runoff from approximately 1.8 acres. The LID practices being applied at Rogers Park include porous asphalt in the parking spaces, infiltration trenches and bioretention with wetland vegetation. LID techniques reduce the amount of stormwater through decreasing impervious surface area. They also improve water quality by redirecting stormwater to treatment areas.

#### **Project Partners**

This project is cooperatively funded by the District and Hernando County.

#### **Project Timeline**

Construction for this project is scheduled to begin in the fall of 2017 and will take up to four months to complete. The park will be closed during construction.

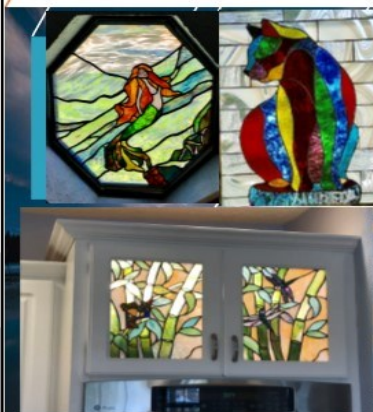

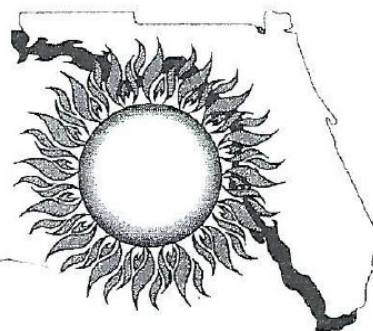

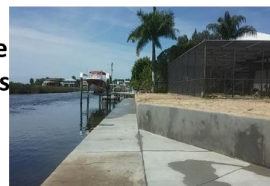
