

Sergeant Jennifer M. Hartman, USA (New Ringgold, PA, 21 years)

4th Support Battalion, 1st Brigade, 4th Infantry Division, Fort Hood, TX

Died: 14 Sep 06, Baghdad, Iraq

SGT Hartman died of injuries suffered when a vehicle-borne improvised explosive device detonated in the vicinity of a West Baghdad Substation where she was located.

First Lieutenant Ashley L. (Henderson) Huff, USA (Belle Mead, NJ, 23 years)

549th Military Police Company, 385th Military Police Battalion, Fort Stewart, GA

Died: 19 Sep 06, Mosul, Iraq

1LT Huff died when a suicide vehicle-borne improvised explosive device detonated near her mounted patrol during combat operations.

Sergeant Denise A. Lannaman, NY ARNG (Bayside, NY, 46 years)

1569th Transportation Company, Newburgh, NY

Died 1 Oct 06, Camp Arifjan, Kuwait

SGT Lannaman died from a non-combat related incident.

Sergeant Jeannette T. Dunn, USA (Bronx, NY, 44 years)

15th Sustainment Brigade, 1st Cavalry Division, Fort Hood, TX

Died 26 Nov 06, Taji, Iraq

SGT Dunn died of injuries suffered from a non-combat related injury.

Major Megan M. McClung, USMC (Coupeville, WA, 34 years)

I Marine Expeditionary Force Headquarters Group, I MEF, Camp Pendleton, CA

Died: 6 Dec 06, Al Anbar province, Iraq

Maj McClung was serving as a Public Affairs Officer and combat correspondent. She was killed by a roadside bomb near Ramadi in the last month of her deployment. Megan was an accomplished marathoner and triathlete. She left behind her parents and brother.

Major Gloria D. Davis, USA (St. Louis, MO, 47 years)

Died: 12 Dec 06, Baghdad, Iraq

MAJ Davis died from a non-combat related incident.

Seaman Sandra S. (Grant) Fry, USN (Linwood, NC, 23 years)

USS Eisenhower

Seaman Grant died from natural causes. She left behind her parents, husband and an 8 month old son.
