MEASURING - All dogs that have to be measured must be done before Briefing. Dogs with a wither height of 20" or less will need show proof of measurement or be measured at the trial, unless they are jumping in the highest jump height in that category/division.

AWARDS – First through fourth place ribbons will be awarded for each jump height in all classes and levels. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for each qualifying run. Rosette will be awarded for new titles. High in Trial - A large rosette will be given to the High in Trial Australian Shepherd and High in Trial Other Breed. ASCA registration or QT Tracking Number is required. Must enter at least 8 classes to be eligible. Pre-Novice and FEO do not count for High in Trial. Each 10 point Q is 1 point and a 5 point Q is 1/2 point. In the event of a tie, the following procedures shall be used for breaking the tie. First tie breaker: The dog with the most points in all rounds of the Regular classes. Second tie breaker: The dog with the highest number of total gamble points with a qualifying score. Third tie breaker: The dog with the most points in all rounds of the Jumpers classes. If you may finish an ATCH or ACE during this trial, please inform the Trial Secretary before the trial Volunteers are needed to run the trial, we need everyone's help for a successful efficient trial. Thank you for your help!

Pre-trial help in the mornings is also needed please let trail secretary know if you are able to help.

We will be using a white board sign up system for volunteers. Please sign up early to fill all spots. Lunch will be provided each day for those workers volunteering for at least 2 classes each day.

Trial Photography Official Trial Photographer taking for resale must be approved by the Trial Chair prior to taking photographs. Official Trial Photographers must respect all handler requests regarding taking photographs of said handler and their dog(s).

OPTIONAL ADDITIONAL CLASSES

PRE-NOVICE - The Pre-Novice class is a non-regular (non-titling) class open to any dog over the age of age of 12 months. Dogs under 18 months entered in the Pre-Novice class must jump at least 4" lower than their normal jump height. The teeter-totter and weave poles will not be used. (Shown as the Pre Nov level on the entry form.) N/A

FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY) - The minimum age for dogs entered in FEO is 15 months of age. Any dog younger than 18 months of age must jump at a lower height than their regular jump height. No points towards titles will be earned in this division

FOOD Lunch will be provided for Saturday, Sunday and Monday for volunteers that work 2 or more classes per day. You must fill out the volunteer form to receive lunch.

TRIAL SITE INFORMATION - The trial will be one ring, 100'x100', outdoors on grass. Equipment may include: Dog walk, A-Frame, teeter, open tunnels, weave poles (24" spacing), winged jumps, non-winged jumps, double jump. NOTE: Dogwalk and A-Frame 5' will be slatted and rubberized, teeter is rubberized.

- EXIBITORS through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA® rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

This trial is sanctioned by the Australian Shepherd Club of America (ASCA®) with the Approved by Dogs LLC. As the sponsor club. Exhibitors through submission of their entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA® rules and regulations, including the following rules regarding entry.

- All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen (18) months of age are eligible to compete in ASCA® agility trials.
- The handlers should always conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike fashion.
- Bitches in heat, lame or blind dogs are ineligible for entry.
- Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, must be excused from the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the agility trial.
- I (we) further agree that when my dog(s) are left unattended, they will be secured in a crate or x-pen. Owners/handlers whose dogs are tethered or improperly secured will not be allowed on the show grounds.
- No collars, leads, food, toys, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within ten feet of the ring entrance at any time. The only exception to this is leading your dog to the start on lead, and then handing the lead to a steward. All dogs should be on leash when not competing.
- Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA® agility program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA® programs; or a member not in good standing with ASCA®.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- Participation is a privilege afforded by the Host club and may be extended or withdrawn by the Host club's trial committee on suitable cause only. Refusal of such entries will be reported to ASCA®.
- There will be no refunds in the event that a dog and or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason.
- A 100% refund will be given for any request received prior to pre-entries closing date. Requests for a refund of entry fees after the pre entries closing date, up to the day
 before the trial, will be honored less 20 % and or any expenses incurred by Approved by Dogs LLC, and will be issued for the following reasons: bitches in heat, dogs injured
 or ill (with verification from vet on request).
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$30.00 sersvice charge for bank returned checks.
- In the event that the trial cannot be held for reasons beyond the show host's control, no refunds will be made.
- Dogs entered in the Junior Handlers Division classes may jump 4" lower than their regular jump height.
- Illegible or incomplete entry forms do not constitute a valid entry. Entries' must be signed to be valid.
- The Championship Veteran Dog Division is open to any dog age seven (7) or older. Dogs entered in the Championship Veteran Dog Division classes will jump 4" lower than their Championship Standard jump height.
 - The ACE Senior Dog Division is open to any dog age ten (10) or older. Dogs entered in the ACE Senior Dog Division classes will jump 4" lower than their ACE Standard jump height.
- Current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption List, description of classes, levels, and divisions are included in the current ASCA® Agility Rules and Regulations Handbook.

ASCA® ENTRY INFORMATION

- All ASCA® agility trials are open to purebred and mixed breed dogs.
- Dogs do not have to have an ASCA® registration or QT number to participate in an ASCA® agility trial
- If your dog is an ASCA® registered Australian Shepherd, fill in your dog's ASCA® registration number where designated on the entry form.
- If your dog is not an ASCA® registered Australian Shepherd and you would like to earn ASCA® titles, you need to obtain an ASCA® QT number for your dog. Any dog is eligible to get an ASCA® QT number (not just Australian Shepherds). Once you have an ASCA® QT number, use it as your dog's ASCA® registration number. The ASCA® Service Membership and QT Number Application can be obtained at the ASCA® website (www.asca.org) under "General Forms" and will also be available at the trial.
