

Basic Pant Class

Required items:

- Notepaper/pen
- Eureka! Pant Pattern (available at sewBoise). If you have had a pant muslin fitting, mark your pattern adjustments prior to class.
- Fashion fabric appropriate for making pants (bottom-weight woven fabrics such as cotton sateen, wool gabardine, or cotton twill – a small amount of Lycra added is acceptable, < 3%). Pre-wash and dry your fabric in the manner you will launder it once it's a garment. Refer to your body measurements and chart from the Eureka! Pant Pattern for exact yardage required.
- Matching high-quality polyester thread (we like Mettler or Gutermann)
- ½ yard of high-quality, light to mid-weight, woven fusible interfacing (available for purchase at sewBoise if desired)
- Matching 12" (or longer) invisible zipper

Provided items:

- ✓ Hook & eye

The following items are not required, as the sewing classroom is well-equipped, but you may choose to have your own:

- Scissors and/or rotary cutter
- Glass or metal head Pins & Pin cushion
- Seam ripper
- Tape Measure
- Hem gauge
- Small see-through ruler (approx 2" x 18" and flexible)
- Larger ruler (approx 6" x 24")
- Hand sewing needles
- Bees' wax or Thread Heaven
- Thread clippers
- Magnifier glasses
- Tailor's chalk or other marking tool(s)
- Supply bin/tote
- Sewing machine
