Joseph: Crushed to in Charge February 2016 sermon series

7 Naked and Afraid Gen 39:1-20

Ever have to move away from home? Were you nervous? Excited? Overwhelmed? Prepared? What about confused; wonder if Joseph felt that. Could you blame him? Betrayed by his brothers, sold into slavery, his story is one of rags to riches in his very successful career...until his boss' wife goes all cougar on him. What should you do when you have the chance to toss away your integrity in a single, unexpected moment? Run away, naked if you have to.

14 Inmate That DOES Run the Prison Gen 39:20-23

Ever use the phrase "Don't let the inmates run the prison!"? Never a sound work strategy, is it? And yet, that's exactly what happens to Joseph (spoiler!) when he is stuck in prison. When we find ourselves living in a place we never wanted, with a job we hate, surrounded by people we don't want to be around, the good news is: God has us right where he needs us.

21 Forgotten Promise Gen 40

Joseph has a particular set of skills, and understanding weird dreams is one of them. (Wish you had that gift?) He helps as few of his fellow political prisoners understand what the future holds for each, and sure enough, they come true! With a promise to not be forgotten when his friends are released, Joseph waits for the same. Only one problem - that never happens; he's forgotten. Know the pain of having a loved one promise to never forget you, only to have that promise broken - and your heart crushed?

28 Regret Gen 42

Time supposedly heals all wounds, right? (Anybody else want to smack the person that came up with that brilliant thought? Get in line!) Suddenly, Joseph finds himself face to face with the very brothers that betrayed him years ago, and with the power to help them. Instead, he's has fun messing with them. Their reaction? Regret.
