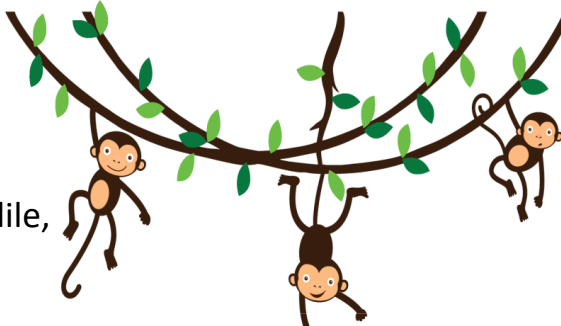

## This Little Tiger

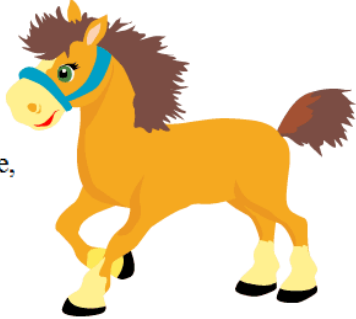
This little tiger is very wild.

But his teeth are too small to bite very well.



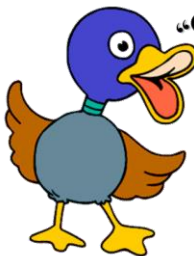

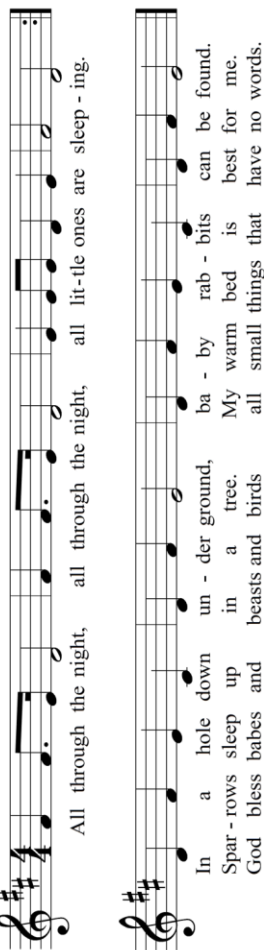

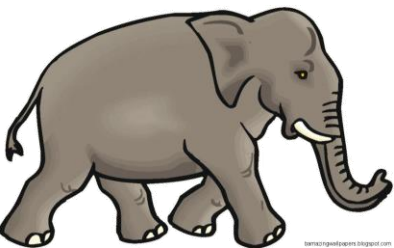

## All Little Ones Are Sleeping

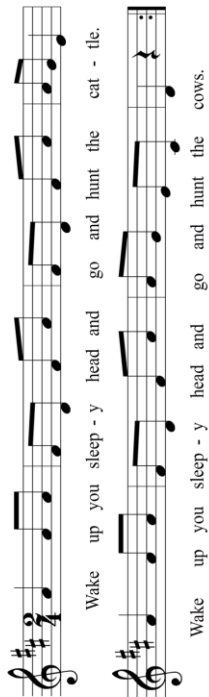


All through the night, all through the night, all lit-tle ones are sleep-ing.

## King of the Jungle

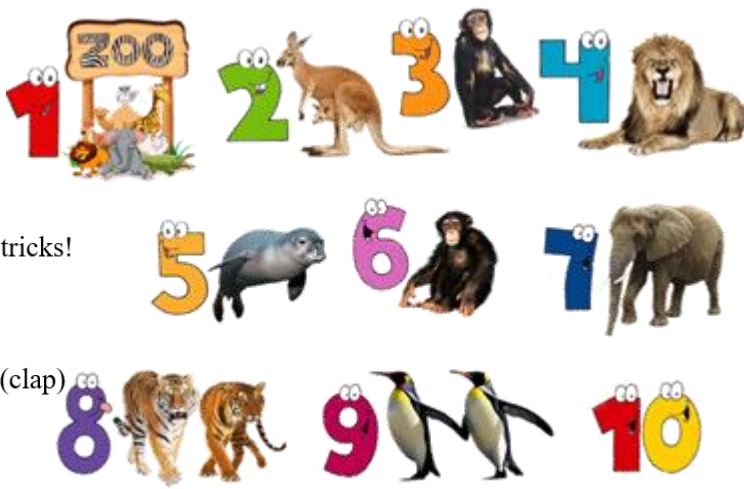

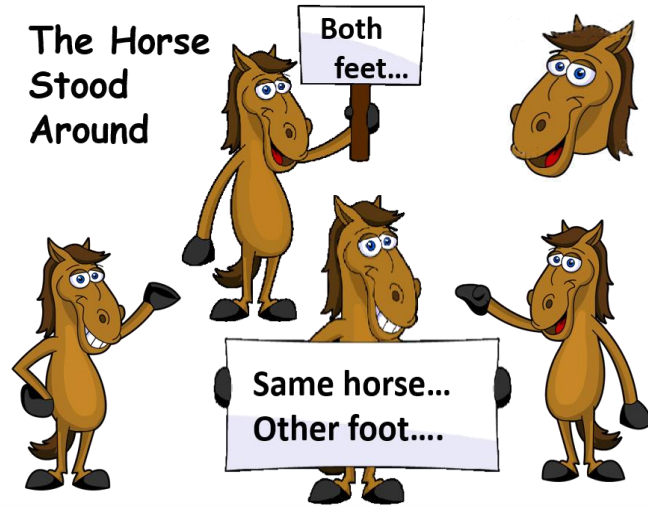

Leave them a-lone and they'll come home, drag-ging their tails be-hind them.



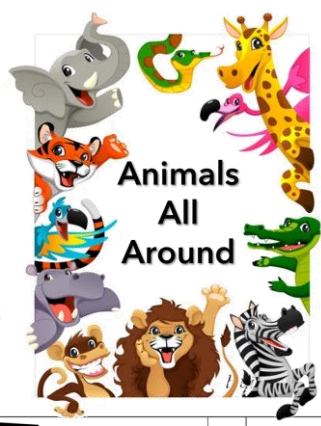
