1. Exhibitors must reside within the Southwest District.

- 2. ALL entries must be made on-line. Entry tags will NOT be printed at fairgrounds.
- 3. All entries must be placed in the Food Preservation Building and have been grown by the exhibitor.
- 4. Prior written permission from the fair office or division chairman must be obtained and presented in order to check entries out before the release date.
- 5. Each exhibitor is limited to one entry per class and must furnish jars when applicable.
- 6. Ribbons and cash prizes will be awarded. Points will be awarded as follows:

1st 2nd 3rd 4th 5th Best of Show

- 7. A screening committee shall determine worthiness of products for exhibits. No products will be accepted with artificial coloring, wax, varnished, oil, etc.
- 8. No entry may be made in "other" when like entry is in another class.
- 9. All classes will have Junior competition, registered under "Junior Horticulture.". Each plate will be marked to distinguish Junior from Senior entries. Junior division includes youth in grades 1 through 12.
- 10. Register at the times above or at your county extension office.
- 11. There will be a guard on duty during times the show is open. The Southwest Arkansas District Fair will not be responsible for loss or damage of exhibits or personal property of exhibitors and is not responsible for exhibits not picked up at the specified time.
