

ADVOCACY IN ACTION: NCJW BELIEVES IN SECOND CHANCES – AMENDMENT 4 PASSED!

Kudos to everyone who worked on passage of Amendment 4, restoration of voting rights to felons who have completed all terms of their sentences. Amendment 4 received more than the required percentage of votes. It was the position of NCJW that restoration was the right thing to do, according to our Jewish values. As a result, beginning in January 2019, about 1.4 million people will be allowed to register to vote, and regain their voice in democracy. NCJW took a stand, and our efforts will make a difference to many in Florida.


