- 3. A maximum of three entries per category, per entrant will be accepted for judging.
- 4. All exhibits must be passed by the entry committee. The entry committee is the final authority in disqualifying entries not conforming to the rules.
- 5. Judging will be completed by qualified individuals. Each exhibit is judged on its own merit. Ribbons in each class will be awarded: blue, red, white, green and best of class, and best of show will be awarded.

  8. No exhibit or award may be removed before Saturday, March 30, 2024
- 8. No exhibit or award may be removed before Saturday, March 30, 2024 before 3:00 p.m. Exhibit pick-up will be Saturday, March 30th from 3:00 6:00 p.m.
