Join us for the first production of TADA's "Sleeping Beauty!" Performances will be held at the Crighton Theater in Conroe, on Sunday, March 3rd!

Time Commitment: Dancers must be available for all rehearsals/shows. More than one unexcused absence, *regardless of the reason* (sick, family-related, etc.) will potentially render your dancer unable to perform. This is because rehearsals are held in a very short amount of time, so your presence is critical to them all. Be sure you can commit to the following before auditioning:

- Sunday, November 4th: Auditions. Register online at www.danceTADA.com
- Sunday, November 25th: 5:30-6:30pm MANDATORY PARENT MEETING
- Friday, January 4-Saturday, January 5th: 10am-6pm Rehearsals for YBC DANCERS ONLY
- Sundays January 6th thru February 24th: Rehearsals begin for all Sleeping Beauty Cast members. Rehearsals from 1-5:30pm. Dancers will arrive fully warmed up and attend rehearsals according to their role(s). An exact schedule of every Sunday will be posted via our Sleeping Beauty page on our website, no later than November 30th. Younger dancers with smaller roles usually don't stay as long, as we try and get them finished quicker. Full Cast run thru rehearsals begin in February, so be prepared for ALL DANCERS to attend all hours of Full Cast Run Thru rehearsals.
- Monday, January 21st: MANDATORY Sleeping Beauty Rehearsals, 9am-2pm
- Monday, January 21st; Sleeping Beauty Picture Day, tentatively 2-7pm
- Sunday, February 10th: MANDATORY Sleeping Beauty Tea Party Fundraiser at Carlton Woods
- Friday, March 1st: Dress Rehearsals at Crighton Theater: Times TBD
- Saturday, March 2nd: Full Cast rehearsals at TADA
- Sunday, March 3rd: Sleeping Beauty Performances 1pm and 5pm

Mandatory Service Hours per Family, or Buy Out: Each FAMILY must contribute at least 5 hours of volunteer service. This could include performing in the production itself, helping with the Sleeping Beauty Tea Party, prop building, costuming, fundraising, working backstage, etc. A family representative must attend the mandatory parent meeting in September to sign up. You may BUY OUT of your service hours for \$125, per family.

Fees and Due Dates: All fees, including Sleeping Beauty company fee and costume fees, are non-refundable and non-transferrable.

- Due November 16th: \$125 Sleeping Beauty Company fee per dancer, which covers all Sleeping Beauty classes/rehearsals, teacher/director pay, administration, guest performer compensation, props, venue, publicity costs, etc. **YBC DANCERS ONLY PAY \$50
- **Due December 10th:** Costume Fees and Service Hours Buyout (if applicable). \$70 costume fee for the first costume, and \$50 per additional costume, if cast in more roles. Please remember that you can designate the maximum number of roles you would like to be cast in, to help budget for costume fees.
- **Due January 8:** Picture Day Fee of \$40 per dancer. Dancers and families will receive <u>all</u> picture taken on Picture Day, via download. No individual pictures need to be purchased. Dancers must attend Picture Day.
