FIESTA CUP CHAMPIONS: Top 2 twirlers in each age division will twirl-off, Beginner, Intermediate, and Advanced levels. The Advanced Fiesta cup will be a perpetual (Traveling) Award to be returned in 2017 for presentation. Winner's name to be engraved on plate.

MISS MAJORETTE OF SOUTH TEXAS PAGEANT: Judged 40% twirling, 40% strutting, 20% modeling,

Modeling attire for Advanced: 0-6 Party Dress; 7-9 Party Dress; 10-12 Party Dress or Formal; 13-15, 16+ Formal.

Modeling attire for Beginner and Intermediate: Strut or Solo Costume. Twirl status determines level of competition.

MISS COLLEGE MAJORETTE OF SOUTH TEXAS PAGEANT: Judged 40% twirling, 40% strutting, 20% modeling in evening gown.

Must be attending college.

MISS RIVER CITY MODELING PAGEANT: Judged on 50% modeling, 50% interview. Modeling will break ties. Modeling attire: dress or costume.

BASIC SKILLS PAGEANT: Open to Novice twirlers only. Judged on 40% basic strut, 40% twirling, 20% modeling in costume. No interview.

"FIRST TROPHY": Best Appearing in Costume for competitors who have never won first place in best appearing in costume.

PARADE MAJORETTE / TWIRL STRUT: Marching with twirling. Floor pattern optional.

Judged on variety, difficulty, and execution of baton twirling with bodywork while staying in step.

RHYTHMIC TWIRL: 1:30 to 2:30 minutes. Provide your choice of music. Advanced Only

COLLEGIATE TWIRL: 2:20 to 2:30 minutes. One Division (Men & Women) Provide your choice of music.

COLLEGIATE DOWNFIELD STRUT: Performed to Notre Dame Fight Song. One Division

UIL/SCHOOL AUDITION: 2:00+ minutes. Provide you choice of music

DUETS: Same as Solos. Classification: Twirling. Divisions determined by combined ages.

TRIOS: 2 to 3 minutes. Classification: Twirling. Divisions determined by average age - Juvenile 0-11, Junior 11.1 - 13.9, Senior 14+.

CORPS: 12 or more members. Classifications: 1) Parade 2) Twirling with props 3) Twirling 4) Street Parade 5) Show Production.

Divisions: Determined by average age as of 09/01/2016 - Juvenile 0-11, Junior 11.1-13.9, Senior 14+.

TEAMS: Sizes: Small – 4 to 8 members, Large – 9+ members. Performance: 2-3 minutes.

Judged on precision, degree of difficulty and risk, staging, use of space, floor designs, audience appeal, showmanship and presentation.

Classifications: 1) Free Style Twirl – props may also be used with baton 2) Pom Pom 3) Dance Line – props may also be used with dance
