If you are a current registered member of Holy Angels parish **it is still necessary for you to complete the census form.** This has impact on sponsorship letters and other parish services.

CONTRIBUTION STATEMENTS 2017

SPONSOR CERTIFICATES

All Catholics should be registered in the parish of their residence where they worship regularly. From time to time, individuals call the Parish Office to receive letters or certificates to be godparents for Baptism and sponsors for Confirmation. Occasionally, we are unable to find the person listed in our records; generally for two reasons.

- They never formally registered (this is different from receiving envelopes) or
- Two, they continue to be listed under their parents' membership, even though they are now adults; no longer in high school, in professional institutes, and/or in college.

Some are no longer living with their parents or are living in another city. Young adults over 21 (25 if in college), should register separately.

Just because a person was baptized, went to school or married at our church does not make that person a registered parishioner.

These Certificates or Letters of Eligibility to act as a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation cannot be issued unless you are already (preferably for 6 months) registered with Holy Angels Parish.
