We are grateful to report that, with full house patient revenue, generous contributions from individuals and churches, as well as grants and bequests, Desert View was able to meet its expenses last year. We are continually evaluating cost-saving measures, so that we achieve sustainability and do not deplete our savings unnecessarily. Our goal is to be able to meet our operating expenses solely from patient revenue and contributions and, eventually, investment income. Patient revenue alone cannot cover all expenses, even with a full house--thus the importance of contributions from the field. In our own individual ways, we each need to plant and harvest annually. How much to give is up to each individual or branch church to decide. Even very small gifts of \$5 or \$10 a month will be so helpful! We appreciate all contributions, as they evidence your support for our mission--providing Christian Science Nursing Care for those relying on Christian Science for healing.
