not have that right, but in order to give you an example to imitate.

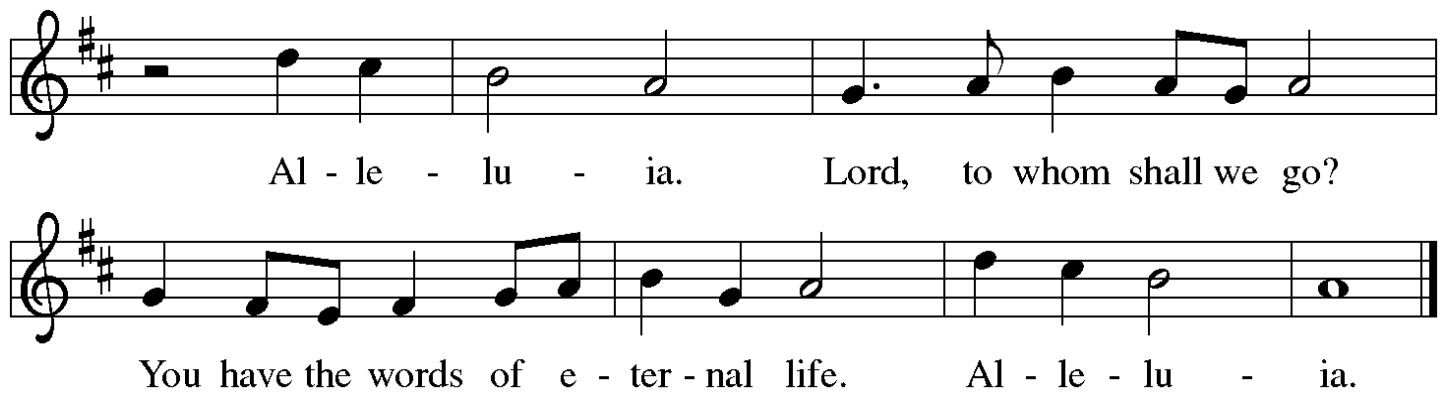
