PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Cypress Hills Interprovincial Park is located in the Cypress Hills, spanning an area between SE Alberta and SW Saskatchewan. This project involved an expansion of 23 campsites to an existing campground, as well as expansion and overlay to an adjacent parking lot, which services the park's west end boat launch. There were considerable challenges in designing the grading to accommodate the existing contours and the requirements of RV parking.

The existing parking lot and day use area was rehabilitated and repaved. Current grading issues causing storm run off problems were also addressed to mitigate the effects of water infiltrating the asphalt structure.

SERVICES WE PROVIDED:

Review of previous landscape architectural plans; extensive site surveys and ground contour mapping; preparation of grading plan; coordination and review of geotechnical investigation. Construction tendering and management for multiple contracts and contractors was also undertaken within a tight schedule window.
