Little Miss Pageant Rules

1. Contestants must be girls ages 6 –10 year old by July 1, 2018.
2. Contestants must be a U.S. Citizen and a resident of Stephenson County, unless, the county they reside in does not offer a fair pageant. Proof of legal residence must be provided if requested by pageant officials.
3. Each contestant agrees to be personally interviewed by the judges, required to appear in a knee length dress, and participate in a production number.
4. The newly selected Little Miss will assist the newly crowned Queen as hostess of the Stephenson County Fair, June 27-July 1, 2018. An itinerary of duties for the week of the Stephenson County Fair will be given to the Little Miss by the pageant committee.
5. Decisions of the judges are final. Any grievances or objections relative to the contest will be referred to the Pageant Committee of the Stephenson County Fair Association.
6. Prerequisites and duties of the newly selected Little Miss will be:
 - A. The Little Miss will represent the Stephenson County Fair at as many other area Pageants and fair association functions as possible. She will be chaperoned either by the Pageant Director, Pageant Coordinator or a chaperone approved by the Director at any time she is representing the Stephenson County Fair.
 - B. All personal appearances as Little Miss shall be approved in advance by the Pageant Director or Pageant Coordinator; as well as any photographic sessions and pictures released as the role of Little Miss.

Practices are mandatory unless excused in advanced by the pageant director.

Extra practice may be added if committee feels it is needed

June 1st: Deadline for applications and entry fee must be submitted. This date may be extend to the first week of practice depending on number of applications.

June 3rd: Practice at 3:00 pm, Farm Bureau Building (**All attire must be approved by the director and committee**)

June 16th: Practice at 3:00 pm, Farm Bureau Building

June 17th: Father's Day-No practice

June 24th: Interviews with Judges: Farm Bureau, time TBA

June 25th: Practice at 3:00 pm, Farm Bureau Building

June 26: **Final Rehearsal** at 4:00 pm., Rest & Entertainment Tent on the fairgrounds, all contestants.

June 27: Pageant at 4:00 pm., Rest & Entertainment Tent (**time for contestants to arrive will be determined and contestants informed at the June 25th practice**)
