ISRAEL ITINERARY

WED, Jun 6, 2018

Depart San Francisco to Tel Aviv. We must be at the airport least 2 hours before flight time.

THU, Jun 7, 2018

Tel Aviv

We arrive late evening. Upon arrival, we are met and assisted by our guide. Our coach is waiting and we transfer to our hotel for overnight.

OVERNIGHT TEL AVIV

FRI, Jun 8, 2018

Jaffa/Valley of Ella/ Caesarea / Mt. Carmel

After breakfast, we travel this morning to the Elah Valley where David slew Goliath and then to Jaffa, the home of Simon the Tanner and where Jonah set forth for his encounter with the big fish. We travel toward Galilee along the Mediterranean coastal road to the ruins of Caesarea, the ancient Roman capital, built by Herod the Great in 22 BC. The apostle Paul was imprisoned here before being sent to Rome. Pilate lived here during the time of Jesus' crucifixion. Cornelius and his household lived here too. Visit the Roman Theatre, the Aqueduct and Herodian Port. Continue toward Haifa, to see the magnificent panoramic view from Mount Carmel. Visit the Mukraka, the location of Elijah's altar where he slew the prophets of Baal.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT GALILEE

SAT, Jun 9, 2018

Gideon Springs /

Meggido / Sepphoris / Nazareth / Galilee

After our good night's rest we drive to Gideon Springs where Gideon chose 300 men to fight the Midianites. Afterwards, we visit the Valley of Armageddon and the excavation of Tel Megiddo which is 30 civilizations deep going all the way back to the Canaanites. Here are Ahab's water tunnel and Solomon's stables. We continue to Sepphoris, a town where Jesus may have worked alongside Joseph. The town was being built when Jesus was a boy. This is the hometown of Jesus' mother Mary. There is a famous mosaic called the Mona Lisa of the Galilee here. We travel to Jesus' boyhood home of Nazareth where we visit Nazareth Village, a recreated village as it was during the childhood of Jesus and then Mary's well.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT GALILEE

SUN, Jun 10, 2018

Boat Ride / Jesus Boat /

Mt of Beatitudes / Tabgha / Capernaum /

Tel Dan / Caesarea Philippi / Golan Hts / Yardenit

Take a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, then visit Jesus Boat and the nearby site of the Sermon on the Mount. Visit Tabgha where Jesus fed 5000 with the loaves and the fishes of a small boy. Continue to Capernaum, central to Jesus ministry and the city of Simon Peter's house where the paralytic was healed. The foundation of the synagogue in which Jesus preached is also still seen. Visit Tel Dan, where Jeroboam challenged the temple in Jerusalem with a golden calf. Nearby we visit Caesarea Philippi, site of pagan altars, where Peter confessed Christ. Journeying back toward Tiberias via the Golan Heights we learn of Israel's great victory over Syria in recent history. Before dinner, we stop at Yardenit on the Jordan River where you can be baptized

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT GALILEE

MON, Jun 11, 2018

Kursi / Beit She'an /

Bedouin Lunch / Bethlehem / Jerusalem

After breakfast and on our way to Jerusalem we visit Kursi where Jesus cast the demons into swine and saw them plunge into the sea to drown. We continue to the newly excavated ruins of Beit She'an where the bodies of Saul and his sons were displayed on the walls after their defeat at Mount Gilboa. Continuing down the Jordan River valley we stop near Jericho, the oldest inhabited city on earth for an overlook. Continuing up the road to Jerusalem, we stop at Genesis Land for lunch and then proceed to Bethlehem to see the shepherd's fields and the cave where Jesus was born.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT JERUSALEM

TUE, Jun 12, 2018

Jerusalem /Old City

Drive to the Mount of Olives for an outstanding view of the city and surrounding area. Visit the Chapel of the Ascension, Garden of Gethsemane, and Church of All Nations. See the Kidron Valley, Tomb of Absalom, Zachariah and James. On our walking tour we proceed to the temple area on Mt. Moriah where we visit the Davidson Center, a recently excavated archeological site near the southern wall of Temple Mount in the Old City. We have a virtual walk through the temple as it was at the time of Jesus. Afterwards we see the Dome of the Rock, visit the Western Wall, and walk through the Kotel Tunnel. We also visit the Golden Gate, the Pinnacle, St. Stephen's Gate, the Pool of Bethesda, the Chapel of the Flagellation and the Ecce Homo Arch. We continue through the Bazaar to the last stations of

the Via Dolorosa. Visit the Roman Cardo, and stop at sites on Mt Zion including the House of Caiaphas, the Room of the Last Supper and King David's Tomb.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT JERUSALEM

WED, Jun 13, 2018

Jerusalem / New City

This morning, we proceed past the Knesset to the Israel Museum. Visit the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scroll collection is exhibited and where the model of ancient Jerusalem is displayed. Visit Yad Vashem, the holocaust memorial. In mid-afternoon, we visit Hezekiah's Tunnel and finally the Garden Tomb of Jesus where we have an orientation beside Calvary and communion.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT JERUSALEM

THU, Jun 14, 2018

Dead Sea / Qumran / En Gedi / Masada

Leave Jerusalem for the Shore of the Dead Sea -the deepest point on earth (1368 feet below sea level). Drive via the Judean Wilderness to the Dead Sea via Ein Fescha to Qumran, the ruins of an ancient Essene community where the Dead Sea scrolls were found. Enjoy a short swim in the Dead Sea and travel via the Judean Wilderness. Then drive to the Nature Reserve Ein Gedi, where King David found shelter from the rage of King Saul. Ascend to Masada by cable car to visit these magnificent ruins. Masada is the fortress where from 70-73 AD the Jewish Zealots made the last stand against the Roman Empire. We travel back to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.
