



After Treatment

Our 3 Step Treatment (Vacuum comb, Conditioner Oil treatment & Post Care Instructions) has a 100% success rate.

Its crucial to follow our Post care Treatment Schedule to Guarantee Complete Success.

Post Care

Change Clothes immediately so if any lice have fallen on clothing it will prevent Re-infestation.

Leave Treatment in hair for at least 3 hours while you thoroughly clean house.

Wash Hair with shampoo thoroughly and condition if necessary.

Combing Schedule

After our Treatment you should be 100% Lice and Nit free. However, It's Imperative to comb after any treatment to make sure nothing is Cross contaminated from environment or another person. Combing should only take a few minutes, that is all. Comb the second day after you've been treated, Take two days off, then comb again for two days. Then your done!

Combing Instructions

Wet hair thoroughly. Comb through with Hair Fairy Godmother comb, wiping on paper towel after every few swipes. If you are getting nothing after each swipe move on to next section. Make sure you are combing the scalp not just the hair.



Cleaning

After Treatment to hair, leave in product for 3 hours and during this time focus on the following cleaning instructions:

1. Wash and dry bedding
2. Sanitize all hair brushes and accessories by placing them in freezer for 6 hours or placing them in tupperware with boiling water until water cools.
3. Bag stuffed animals, back packs or any un-washable items for at least 48 hours
4. Wipe down or vacuum furniture that has been exposed to lice.



Comb Care

You can sterilize comb by placing it container and pouring boiling water in it. Allow to soak until water turns cool. Remove and air dry.

To prevent damage of comb DO NOT put comb in pan of boiling water!

Preventative

Remember moving forward the best offense with lice is a strong defense.

1. Wear hair up, back or in braid in school
2. Do not share hats or Hair Accessories
3. Bring your own pillow to sleep overs
4. Use a lice repellent daily when your child is around other children
5. Continue to do routine Lice checks at home at least every other week to ward off future infestations.
