Our promise and dedication towards completing the Prayer Shrine in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe and the Mysteries of the Rosary perseveres and each day brings us closer to its completion. We have included an illustration of the Dedication Plaques to give everyone an image of how they look. The plaques will have a significant placement in the Santuario courtyard as you enter. This phase will begin in the spring of 2024.



This is a picture of the completed mission statue of St. Augustine, just received last week. The life-size bronze depiction has temporarily been placed at the church in Antonito and will eventually be placed at the santuario along with six additional mission statues. The process for the next mission statue will begin as entire donations are complete for each figure. We have volunteers actively seeking contributions for the remaining missions of Ortiz, San Rafael, Las Mesitas, San Miguel, and San Antonio.

In addition to the mission statues surrounding the Shrine and the statue of Our Lady Of Guadalupe and St. Juan Diego at the entrance, walkways will lead visitors to various areas of interest. The placement of new trees will also be available to contributors who are interested in dedicating a tree in memory of a family member similar to what now exists on the New Veterans Boulevard entering the Village of Conejos.

MASS READING REFLECTION

FIRST READING
Is 63:16b-17, 19b; 64:2-7
[God Our Redeemer]

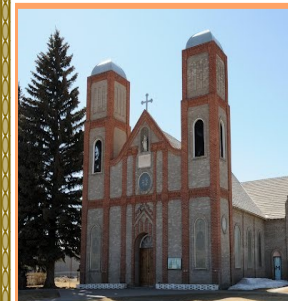
This is a prayer in time of distress. God's people who have returned from exile in Babylon are experiencing frustration. The reconstruction has not worked as they had hoped. They attribute this to their own sins. May God intervene and help! The Responsorial Psalm is a similar prayer. The "shepherd of Israel" is God, leader of his chosen people, us. "The man of your right hand" is the king, representing the people, all of us. Our planet, our community, our family, and we ourselves—all need God to come and save us from the mess we have made of life so often! Advent, the four weeks of preparation for Christmas, means "coming." May God come in his Messiah, Anointed One, Jesus Christ! But in order to receive him, we must open up. "Lord, make us turn to you; let us see your face and we shall be saved" (Responsorial Psalm).

SECOND READING
1 Cor 1:3-9
[Fellowship with Christ]

Paul sees the community of Corinth as waiting for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ. He thanks God for the favors bestowed on them in Christ Jesus: the gift of speech and knowledge. Later in the Letter, he will tell them to use these gifts well! Waiting and persevering to the end requires the strength of God, but they will succeed. "God is faithful." God's word to you could be: You are waiting for the final revelation of Christ. God has bestowed gifts on you. How are you using them? Persevering as a real Christian is not easy. Pray for it! God is faithful.

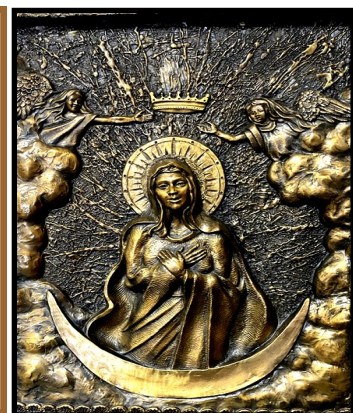
