The food pantry at Trinity, Our Father's Cupboard, served a total of 147 people in April, 2022. A total of 47 families sought free food and personal items during our regularly scheduled drive-through food pantry at our church.

Mission for June - Our Father's Cupboard

Here at Trinity UMC, we provide food, including meat, dairy, eggs, pasta, soups, vegetables, rice, and other personal needs through our program. The meat we provide is usually frozen or in a can. It all depends on what is available from the Greater Lansing Food Bank. We order the items online and individuals drive to pick the food up at the warehouse located in Bath, Michigan.

We put a large, collection box in the Foyer of the church for people to drop off toilet paper, bar soap, toothbrushes, toothpaste, dental floss, deodorant, body wash, shampoo, conditioner, sanitary products, paper towels, cleaners, and dish soap. Families are provided some toilet paper and bar soap, along with other items they may ask for, if we have them.

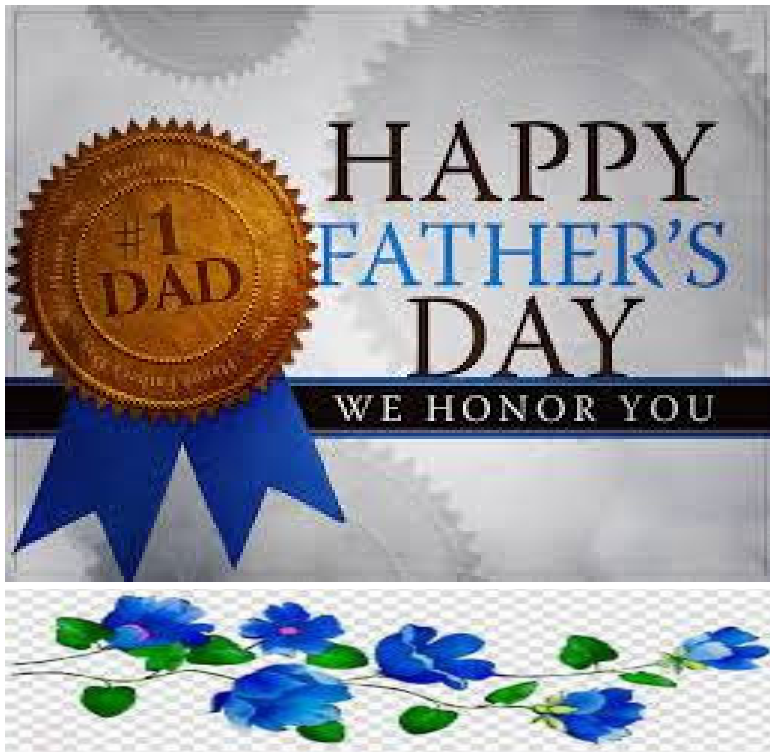

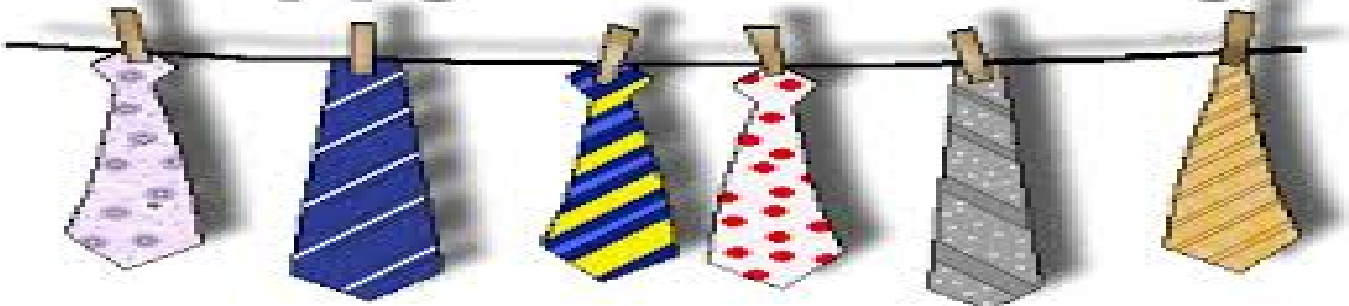
I appreciate the good attendance and all your skills and efforts to do our Lord's service. God watches always for our love together and serving Him.
