September Meeting—Witch 'n Kitty

Witch 'N Kitty Design by Susan Kelly taught by Nancy Genetti

Supplies:

Any size surface – Original on Candy Jar lid and a pumpkin shaped barrel stave. It could be put on a plaque, bowl, paper mache box, etc.

Size the pattern to fit your surface.

Brushes: Variety of flats, angles, and rounds you are comfortable with, ½" map, liner, ¼" stencil brush, and a spatter brush.

Dot tool or use the end of a paint brush or stylus

Americana Pants:

Shale Green Golden Straw

Cool White Burnt Orange

Winter Blue Soft Black

Tangelo Black Green

Lamp Black Grape Juice

Honey Brown Deep Periwinkle



Witch 'n Kitty

Prep Instructions

Basecoat the surface with a double load of Tangelo Orange and Golden Straw. Try to create a streaked appearance, with the streaks going in a horizontal direction.

Basecoat the edge/outside/back with Lamp Black.

Transfer the pattern for the witch's head collar, hat, cat and spider.

Basecoat witch's face with Shale Green

Base the hat with a mix of Soft Black and Grape Juice (1:1) This is not streaked, just mix the two colors together for a dark purple.

Paint the witch's collar with Grape Juice.

Basecoat the cat's cheeks and face with Cool White.

Paint the spider and cat's ears and side of face black

Transfer the details of the pattern on when basecoats are dry.

Come to class ready to paint and have fun!


