# From Our Grand Knight Greetings Brother Knights and Families,

WOW! Where did the year go? I can't believe we are coming into the holiday season already.

What a year we have had, and it is all because of the hard work put forth by all of our members. And because of all the hard work, here are some of the accomplishments we have been able to achieve this year; Nearly 200 food boxes to families in need last December. Over \$5000 donated to the Sacred Heart Major Seminary for their Desert Formation Experience, \$6500 raised & donated for the purchase of a new ultrasound machine, 96 Casey the Teddy Bears donated to local fire & police departments, received state awards for largest increase for the MI drive (tootsie rolls), the Exemplary PR award, the Columbian award and over \$7000 raised for our coats for kids program. These are only some of the highlights of this past year. But I think this biggest highlight was the "Shroud of Turin" display we had at the council. This display brought our community together and united as Christians. This was a powerful display that brought out the love we all have for our Lord.

Through our efforts with all of our projects, we have met and made new contacts throughout the year. I would expect these people will be calling on the Knights again in 2019 and I hope we can come together and lend a helping hand when called upon

As I mentioned earlier, we were able to raise \$7050.00 for our "Coats for Kids" program. A large part of this was from the euchre party that Gary & Bev Thoma (mostly Bev, I think) organized and put on down in the lounge on October 19<sup>th</sup>. Everyone that attended had a great time. Make sure to thank Gary, Bev and their crew for their contributions to the CFK's program. All the money raised will go toward the purchase of new coats. These coats will be going to kids in need at the Monroe Public School, Dundee Community Schools, our parish chapters of St. Vincent DePaul and the Heartbeat of Monroe. THANK YOU to everyone that contributed to this program.

If you have not yet received your 2019 dues notice, you should be getting them soon. Our dues will remain the same as it has for the past few years. There are a couple of new voluntary donations that are listed on this years notice. I wanted to take a moment to explain what these will help support. Both of these programs are State Council programs.

-<u>Ten for Charity</u>- all donations will go to the State K of C charities program. Some of the charities that are supported by our State Council are, All diocese vocations, catholic education, catholic radio, Center for Women, Holy Cross Children Services, Right to Life Agencies, Special Days Cancer Camp, Special Olympics, Solanus Casey Center and many more.

-Sacred Heart Major Seminary Endowed Scholarship Fund- This is a new program this year. Our Past State Deputy, Kenneth Unterbrink, has pledged our help of \$6/member to the SHMS. The reason for this fund, is because so many of the seminarians will reach their final years of studies but would have to drop out because they are unable to pay for their education. The objective for this scholarship fund is to help support the young men who wish to become priests but do not necessarily have the financial support that is required.

I am sure you have all received your invites to our annual Clergy & PGK Appreciation Dinner and memorial mass. As in the past, we will celebrate mass at 5:00 pm with our council Chaplain, Fr. David Burgard, presiding. Mass will be in hall #2. We will once again have the Frenchtown Fiddlers entertaining us with their music during the social hour between the mass and dinner. Dinner will be served at approximately 7:00 pm with the program to follow. If you haven't already done so, please RSVP by December 1<sup>st</sup>. We will not be accepting money at the door.

Due to our State Chaplains tribute dinner, our Major Degree that was scheduled for February 23, 2019 has been rescheduled for February 16, 2019
