Materials Included:

- 2 Balloons
- 2 Paper cups
- 1 Ping Pong Balls

Materials You Need to Gather From Home:

- Scissors
- Tape

Instructions:

- 1) Tie the balloons (not blown up)
- 2) Cut the rounded end of balloon off
- 3) Cut the bottom out of the cup
- 4) Stretch the rounded end of the balloon over the larger side of the paper cup and pull it tight. (The knot should be in the middle of the cup) Secure with tape if needed.
- 5) Put the Ping Pong Ball inside the cup, pull back on the knot and let it fly!
