

Drift Supply & Cutting List

Supplies:

Sew Many Creations Drift Pattern

Pathways Ruler

18-20 fat quarters cut into 6" squares

To finish the quilt after class:

3 ½ yards background fabric (White - towards the top)

½ yard binding

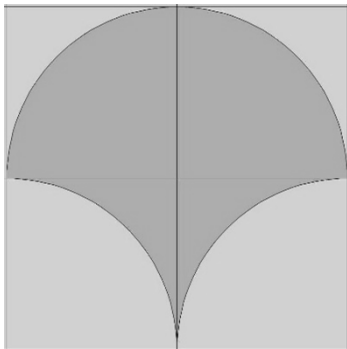
4 yards backing

Twin batting (Quilt is 60" x 75")

A few notes:

What makes this quilt unique is the layout that incorporates Trimmed Drunkard's path blocks to create the "Drift" look, leaving lots of negative space for quilting. I used a computer program (EQ7) to arrange mine but **recommend that you start with the coloring page** included to arrange your layout before doing any cutting. Since I don't know the specific layout that you'll be using, the pattern is written more as a sewing and assembly guide. In class we will learn to cut with the ruler, sew, press and trim the blocks. Your assembly of each block will be the same however the number of squares per color needed will vary. You will need to cut Concave and Convex curves from all fabrics including background fabric. All curves start as 6" squares.

Please feel free to bring scrap fabric if you would prefer to just play with curves in class. You will need 6" squares or various FQ's. We will discuss the assembly of this quilt in class as well.



Example:

This is what 4 trimmed drunkard's path blocks look like to create a complete clamshell or "drift". For this I would need (4) 6" squares of the dark and (4) 6" squares of the light
