Position Summary

Duties include meeting all customer quality and specification requirements, operation of injection molding machines, finishing and trimming of parts, inspecting parts, reporting paperwork, housekeeping duties and other duties as assigned.

Responsibilities

- Trims excess material from part, using knife.
- Grind scrap plastic into powder for reuse.
- Cut off excess material.
- Inspect products for surface defects and flaws.
- Ensure conformance to specifications.
- Coat dies with parting agent.
- Operating plastic injection molding machines and inspecting product
- Package product to customer requirements, label product containers with proper ID label, identify molding problems, and notify Molding Technician for corrections
- Perform assembly of product as directed, complete daily production activity log, maintain stable mold cycle, and maintain a clean work area

Job Qualifications

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Experience in a plastic manufacturing environment, preferably working with injection molding equipment preferred.
- Basic mathematical aptitude (add, subtract, multiply, divide)
- Ability to multi-task and operate multiple lines.
- For safety and business purposes, must be able to communicate to others, as well as be able to receive communication from others including reading and writing.
