n Sunday March 26th the first worship service concluded with the formation of a circle of people in Williams Hall. We had just heard the story of a man named Honi who earned the title *The Circle Maker* because of his bold, shamelessly audacious prayer. In the century before the birth of Jesus severe drought threatened the inhabitants of Jerusalem. Honi stood outside the city, took up his staff, and drew a circle in the



dirt. Standing in that circle, he then fell to his knees, raised his arms heavenward, and prayed for rain. It came. He prayed for more substantial rain. It came. He prayed for sustained, gentle rain. It came, along with an outpouring of God's presence among the people.

Author Mark Batterson's book entitled, *The Circle Maker* uses the image of drawing a circle of prayer. Drawing a circle around those people, needs, concerns, fears, hopes, and dreams that are on our minds and in our hearts. Then standing in that circle of prayer, you pray boldly, persistently, and expectantly, until the answer comes.

I want to call us to this kind of prayer for Trinity. Please continue to draw a circle around this church, asking God to direct us, equip us, empower us, and use us in amazingly wonderful ways to bless the lives of our friends, neighbors, and surrounding community.
