



Oroville Orcas Swim Team



2018 REGISTRATION AGREEMENT

The undersigned parent/guardian and the Oroville Orcas Team (Orcas) agree as follows:

1. Dues.
 - a. In consideration of the participation of the Swimmer(s) in the Orcas competitive swim team, the parent agrees to pay in full the Orcas and Sierra-Nevada Swimming fees by the first day of practice.
 - b. If the Swimmer quits the swim program or is unable to continue participation in the program; **no dues will be refunded.**
2. Team Assignments. The assignments of the Swimmer(s) to a practice team shall be the decision of the coaching staff. An assignment may be modified during the swim year if the coaching staff believes a different practice team would be more appropriate for the swimmer.
3. Release of Liability. Parent hereby releases Oroville Orcas, its employees, officers, directors and volunteers and any facility used by Oroville Orcas from any liability arising out of any injury to the Swimmer(s) which may occur while the Swimmer(s) is/are participating in the Oroville Orcas swim program, including, but not limited to, practices, meets, travel trips, and other team activities, or while the Swimmer(s) is/are using the facilities owned, leased or used by Oroville Orcas.
4. Fundraising Projects/Swim Meets. Revenue from fundraising and swim meets constitute a significant part of the Orcas operating budget. In any fundraising project or swim meet designated by the Board of Directors as one in which participation is mandatory, Parent/Guardian agrees that at least one adult family member shall participate as a volunteer.

The specific fundraising requirements for 2018 are detailed as follows:

- a. **Participation Requirement** –
 - i. Each family must provide one adult volunteer for at least one home dual meet, to be held at Nelson Pool on Wednesdays. Dates to be announced.
 - ii. Each family that participates at the NVAL Championships must provide one adult volunteer for at least one session at the NVAL Championships.
 - b. **Fundraising requirements** – Families are required to raise a minimum of \$100 for the 2018 swim season. This may be fulfilled through Swim-A-Thon, cash, fundraiser or sponsorship.
5. Parent Release Form for Photo Usage. - I, the undersigned, do hereby grant or deny permission to the Oroville Orcas to use the image of my child, as marked by my selection below. Such use includes the display, distribution, publication, transmission, or otherwise use of photographs, images, and/or video taken of my child for use in materials that include, but may not be limited to, printed materials such as brochures and newsletters, videos and digital images on the Oroville Orcas website or social media accounts.

Deny permission to use my child's image at all. Grant permission to use my child's image.
