**Games in Rotation Order**

**HOME TEAM IN CAPS**

**Thursday, December 26th**

**GameAbove Sports Bowl - Ford Field - Detroit, MI**

† **Pittsburgh 30 Toledo 21.** We hate to keep this simple but this is a one-factor handicap. If Pitt QB Eli Holstein plays, Pitt is the right side, if he doesn't they'll be down to a 3rd stringer. Pitt had the better ypp margin (+0.8 vs +0.4) and played the tougher schedule (No. 60 vs No. 122).

**Rate Bowl - Chase Field - Phoenix, AZ**

† **Kansas State 28 Rutgers 21.** Rutgers won't have their DC and their biggest opt out came on Tuesday when RB Kyle Monangai announced he will sit out. Kansas State will be missing 5 starters and have more players in the transfer portal. Kansas State was much better in the stats (+1.3 vs -0.6 in ypp margin) and played the tougher schedule (No. 34 vs No. 62).

**68 Ventures Bowl - Hancock Whitney Stadium - Mobile, AL**

† **Bowling Green 30 Arkansas State 23.** BG was the much better team in the stats (+0.5 vs -1.6 in yards per play margin). They do have 3 starters who transferred out to Power 4 programs. All 3 of them were All-MAC in RT Wollschlaeger, LB Sipp and RB Stewart. As of press time (Christmas morning), it does appear All-American TE Harold Fannin will play for BG. We don't like this Arkansas St team but they've had minimal opt outs.

**Friday, December 27th**

**Birmingham Bowl - Protective Stadium - Birmingham, AL**

† **Georgia Tech 26 Vanderbilt 24.** One of the better non-playoff matchups. The biggest opt out is Georgia Tech WR Eric Singleton who is off to Auburn. Both teams should be motivated especially Vanderbilt. GT was the better team in the stats (+0.5 vs -0.7 ypp margin) but Vandy did play the tougher schedule and went 7-2 ATS as a dog this year with 4 upsets.

**Armed Forces Bowl - Amon G Carter Stadium - Fort Worth, TX**

† **Oklahoma 24 Navy 20.** There's been huge movement in this game with Oklahoma opening as high as a 10-point favorite and now find themselves only a 3-point favorite. The Sooners will be missing 10 starters and overall have had 24 players hit the transfer portal. Navy will be missing ZERO starters and have had only one player hit the portal. Navy is better in the stats (+0.1 vs -0.7 in ypp margin) but Oklahoma played the much tougher schedule (No. 7 vs No. 91). Michael Hawkins will start at QB for OU and we expect a heavy rush attack. We'll fade the move and lean OU at current.

**Liberty Bowl - Simmons Bank Liberty Stadium - Memphis, TN**

† **Arkansas 27 Texas Tech 26.** Both teams have been ravaged by opt outs. Texas Tech will be missing 7 starters including QB Morton and both coordinators. Freshman Will Hammond will get the start at QB for them. Arkansas is in worse shape as they will be missing 12 starters and have had 27 players hit the transfer portal. The two teams played similar strength of schedules but Arkansas was better at +1.0 in ypp margin (TT -0.5). Slightest of leans on Tech.

**Holiday Bowl - Snapdragon Stadium - San Diego, CA**

† **Syracuse 38 Washington State 19.** The biggest line move of the bowl season so far is in this game. Syracuse opened as low as -2.5 and now find themselves 16.5-point favorites. The Orange should have minimal opt outs according to coach Fran Brown. Meanwhile, Washington State has been decimated more than any other bowl team. The Cougars could be missing 13 starters including their QB Mateer and have had 28 players hit the transfer portal. In addition, they won't have their head coach, both coordinators and multiple assistants. We're not sure how this game will be played. We could only look at Syracuse even after the big move.

**Las Vegas Bowl - Allegiant Stadium - Las Vegas, NV**

† **Texas A&M 27 USC 24.** This would have been one of the best non-play-off games if both teams were at full strength. A&M will be down 5 starters including 3 on the defensive line. USC will be down 6 starters including 3 at WR. USC is much better than their 6-6 record as they were +0.6 in ypp margin (A&M +0.5) despite playing our 5th toughest schedule. They also have played here earlier this year. We haven't bet side or total. Pass.

**Saturday, December 28th**

**Fenway Bowl - Fenway Park - Boston, MA**

† **North Carolina 28 Connecticut 24.** North Carolina fired head coach Mack Brown and TE coach Freddie Kitchens will serve as the interim (former Browns HC). Obviously, the Tar Heels have been in the news with the shocking hire of Bill Belichick to be their new head coach. As far as this game goes, North Carolina will be missing 6 starters including 3 on the defensive line and will also be without their top player in RB Hampton. UConn will be missing 5 starters. As of Wednesday morning, the weather forecast is cold but no wind and precip. NC played the much tougher schedule (No. 67 vs No. 119) and we lean with them at current (-3).

### **Pinstripe Bowl - Yankee Stadium - Bronx, NY**

† **Nebraska 24 Boston College 21.** Probably fitting that the two bowl games played at the Red Sox and Yankees stadiums are going to be played at the same time. Nebraska is making their first bowl game in 8 years! Even though BC is much closer, there should be a very large contingent of Nebraska fans. BC is slightly better in the stats (+0.1 vs -0.1 in ypp margin) but Nebraska played the tougher schedule (No. 40 vs No. 54). Nebraska will be missing 4 starters, have had 24 players hit the portal and will be missing their DC. We lean BC.

### **New Mexico Bowl - University Stadium - Albuquerque, NM**

† **Tcu 34 UL-Lafayette 21.** We're not sure how motivated TCU will be here. With that said, the Horned Frogs have not had a mass exodus of players as they will be missing 4 starters and have 9 transfers. ULL will be missing 5 starters and have 9 transfers as well. ULL was +1.3 in ypp margin but TCU was +1.2 and played a significantly tougher schedule (No. 57 vs No. 120). If ULL QB Wooldridge can't go, we don't see ULL having much success. Lean UNDER.

### **Pop Tarts Bowl - Camping World Stadium - Orlando, FL**

† **Miami, FL 30 Iowa State 27.** This is a one-factor handicap. Will Miami QB Cam Ward play or not. All indications are that he will play but for how long? Miami was the better team statistically (+2.4 in ypp margin vs Iowa State +0.3). Iowa State did play a tougher schedule (No. 36 vs No. 65). As of press-time both teams had minimal opt outs or transfers. Also keep an eye on Miami WR Xavier Restrepo, we think he is 50/50 at best to play.

### **Arizona Bowl - Arizona Stadium - Tucson, AZ**

† **Miami, OH 22 Colorado State 20.** A solid matchup here. Both teams will be down several key contributors. Miami will be missing 5 starters including their top 2 WR's. Colorado State will be missing 6 starters. Despite playing a similar strength of schedule, Miami was much better in the stats at +1.3 in ypp margin (Colorado State +0.2). We've seen UNDER money in the market but not much on the side.

### **Military Bowl - Navy-Marine Corps Stadium - Annapolis, MD**

† **NC State 33 East Carolina 27.** Solid in-state matchup. ECU decided to remove the interim tag off Blake Harrell and he will be coaching his first bowl game. ECU was better in the stats (+0.9 vs 0.0 in ypp margin) but NC State played the much tougher schedule (No. 59 vs No. 125). NC State will be without DC Tony Gibson who left to become the Marshall head coach. However, ECU will be missing 5 starters (NC State 1). We didn't bet side or total. Pass.

### **Alamo Bowl - Alamodome - San Antonio, TX**

† **Colorado 29 BYU 26.** Two conference foes who didn't play each other this season square off here. Obviously, the main factor here revolves around the status of Colorado QB Shedeur Sanders and the Heisman Trophy winner WR/CB Travis Hunter. They say they will play and the current market (Colorado -4) reflects that. Will they play a full-game? We have our doubts. Both teams will be missing a couple of starters. BYU was better in ypp margin (+1.3 vs +1.0). Colorado played the tougher schedule (No. 31 vs No. 46). Anything above 3 and we like BYU here.

### **Independence Bowl - Independence Stadium - Shreveport, LA**

† **Army 30 Louisiana Tech 14.** Army was originally scheduled to play Sun Belt Champ Marshall but the Thundering Herd opted out with so many players in the portal. Army instead gets left with a 5-7 Louisiana Tech that is better than their record. The Bulldogs were 2-5 in games decided by 7 points or less but did cover their last 5 games and were +0.2 in ypp margin. Army will be without top RB Udoh who transferred to Arizona State. Their OL coach left to become the head coach at CMU. We think Army bounces back but don't want to lay the 17.

### **Monday, December 30th**

### **Music City Bowl - Nissan Stadium - Nashville, TN**

† **Missouri 21 Iowa 20.** A solid SEC vs Big Ten matchup. Iowa was better in the stats at +0.7 in ypp margin (Missouri 0.0) and the Hawkeyes played the tougher schedule (No. 38 vs No. 53). Easy play on Iowa +3 then, right? Well, they will be without their top player in RB Kaleb Johnson. Missouri will also be missing WR Luther Burden. Brendan Sullivan is expected to play for Iowa at QB. He gives them a running threat. We haven't bet the side or the total but would lean with Iowa at current.

We think it's the best value bets we make all week. 2020 was the first season where we tracked every single bet we made and posted them in the weekly newsletters. We were very pleased with our 119-76-3 (61%) record on these Sunday bets with an average line value of 2.6 ppg! In 2021, we were 224-196-5 (53.3%) vs the Circa openers with an average line value of 1.8 ppg. In 2022, we were 314-262-14 (54.5%, CLV 417-122-51 +1.65 ppg). ## Games in Rotation Order

## HOME TEAM IN CAPS

### Wednesday, December 25th

**Kansas City 22 PITTSBURGH 21. Merry Christmas!** What a money grab by the NFL to put a couple of games on a Wednesday on Netflix. MLB, NBA and CFB...nothing is stopping the NFL from playing games on any date they please. A win here by the Chiefs and they will clinch the No. 1 seed in the AFC. It's remarkable considering they still have a negative ypp margin on the season. They're taking on a Pittsburgh team that still controls its destiny in the AFC North but do have a much more difficult final 2 games than Baltimore who they are tied with. Both are playing their 3rd game in 11 days but you know, the NFL has to get that TV/Streaming money. We think the Steelers are a great teaser play. **Baltimore 26 HOUSTON 21.** Another matchup between teams that will be in the playoffs. Baltimore is No. 1 in the NFL in ypp margin (+1.6) and are No. 1 in DVOA. They have been favored in every game since the opener. Houston has clinched the AFC South but the Texans suffered another key injury this time to WR Tank Dell. Baltimore games are 12-3 to the OVER this year but Houston's offense is a mess. We don't expect to be involved.

### Thursday, December 26th

**Seattle 24 CHICAGO 20.** The Seahawks are on the outside looking in when it comes to the playoffs now. They had their chances last week vs Minnesota as they had 361-298 yard and 6.0-4.8 yards per play edges but lost. Believe it or not, this is the first time the Seahawks have been favored in 11 games! It is deserved considering the Bears have lost 9 straight (2-6-1 ATS). Not a great spot traveling on a short week during Christmas. Another game we don't expect to have action on.

### Saturday, December 28th

**L.A. Chargers 24 NEW ENGLAND 20.** The Chargers own the tie-breakers over the Broncos having beat them twice. Last week, L.A. trailed Denver 21-10 but a rare "fair catch kick" gave them momentum into halftime and they never looked back. On the other side, the Pats actually out-played the Bills last week as 2-TD underdogs but came up just short. The Chargers have extra rest having played last Thursday. Another game where we don't expect to be too involved. We lean OVER but weather could be a factor.

**CINCINNATI 27 Denver 23.** If the playoffs started today, Denver would get the No. 7 seed but they find themselves an underdog to the Bengals. We've been saying almost all season Cincinnati is better than their record as they are +0.2 in ypp margin (same margin as Denver). Cincy needs to win out and get some help to have a chance. Denver does have extra time to prep having played last Thursday but we lean with Cincinnati here.

**L.A. RAMS 27 Arizona 21.** The Cardinals lost in OT to the Panthers as 5.5-point road favorites last week and got eliminated from the playoffs. They're taking on a red-hot L.A. Rams teams that has won and covered 4 straight and would be the No. 3 seed in the NFC if the season ended today. Statistically, Arizona is the superior team in ypp margin and DVOA. However, they don't have much to play for while L.A. does and the Cardinals had a couple of OL get hurt. This isn't a discount on the Rams though at current price.

### Sunday, December 29th

**Indianapolis 25 N.Y. GIANTS 16.** We don't subscribe to teams "tanking" all the time but it sure looks like that is the case with the Giants. They have now lost 10 straight games and are 1-9 ATS in the process. Last week they were non-competitive vs a rookie QB making his first start in Atlanta's Michael Penix. The good news is that if the Giants play like that the next two weeks, they will get the No. 1 pick in the NFL Draft. Meanwhile, Indianapolis still has slim playoff life as they ran for a franchise record 335 yards in last week's win. We think Indy -2 is a great teaser option.

**WASHINGTON 26 Atlanta 21.** Washington is coming off the thrilling win over Philadelphia where they somehow won despite 5 turnovers. Jayden Daniels became the first Washington QB to throw for 5 TD's in a game since Mark Rypien in 1991. They're taking on an Atlanta team that has new life with QB Michael Penix (18 of 27 for 202 yards and a 0-1 ratio). Playing the lowly Giants also helps. Washington has a slightly better ypp margin and is better in DVOA (No. 8 vs No. 20). Both teams have played weak schedules. Lean to Washington.

**Las Vegas 18 NEW ORLEANS 17.** The Saints are on a short week after getting embarrassed by Green Bay 34-0. Meanwhile, Las Vegas broke their long losing streak vs the Jags. However, in true Raiders' fashion, they most likely lost out on getting the No. 1 pick in the Draft with the win. Both teams are -0.5 in yards per play margin. Las Vegas has played the tougher schedule and the Saints will most likely go to Spencer Rattler again. Lean UNDER which has cashed in 4 straight New Orleans games.

**JACKSONVILLE 21 Tennessee 20.** Hey look another dreadful game between a pair of bottom 5 teams. Tennessee is now 2-13 ATS on the season, one of the worst ATS seasons in NFL history. The Titans STILL took money in the market again last week vs Indianapolis. Who are these people and are they masochists? Jacksonville is 3-12 SU but is a respectable 7-7-1 ATS. Tennessee is better in the stats but we can't trust them at all.

**BUFFALO 28 N.Y. Jets 20.** If the Chiefs win on Christmas Day, then the Bills will no longer have a shot at the No. 1 seed and we wonder how optimal their game-plan will be here. They got out-played by lowly New England last week (outgained 379-324) and QB Allen hit his "funny bone". Meanwhile, the Jets somehow found a way to lose last week despite never punting. They fell to 5-10 ATS. A sharp group took the Jets +10.5 on Tuesday. We agree.

**TAMPA BAY 29 Carolina 20.** Tampa Bay lost control of the NFC South with last week's upset loss to Dallas on SNF. Atlanta owns the tie-breakers due to the 2-0 record vs Tampa this season and if the season ended today, Tampa Bay wouldn't even make the playoffs. They should be able to take their frustrations out on a Carolina team "fat and happy" off a OT upset win over Arizona. Carolina has covered 6 straight games as an underdog. We love Tampa Bay in a teaser down to -2.

**Green Bay 25 MINNESOTA 24.** This is by far the most intriguing game on Sunday. Somehow, somehow, the Vikings can get the No. 1 seed in the NFC if they win the next two weeks (at Detroit next week). Not bad for a team that had a win total of 6.5 in the summer. Let's be real though, the Vikings have been fortunate as they are 8-1 in one possession games. Last week they got outgained 361-298 and were -1.2 in ypp margin but won 27-24 at Seattle. On the other side, the Packers have been statistically more dominant ranking No. 2 in ypp margin and No. 3 in DVOA. Green Bay lost the earlier meeting 31-29 but we think they get revenge here.

**PHILADELPHIA 25 Dallas 17.** Say what you want about Mike McCarthy and the Cowboys but they have not given up on the season yet. Dallas enters having won and covered 4 of their last 5 games including the upset over Tampa Bay on SNF. Speaking of upsets, Philadelphia's 10-game win streak was snapped last week as they lost to Washington 36-33 in the final seconds as 4-point road favorites. The Eagles were +3 in TO's and led by 14 but lost QB Jalen Hurts to a concussion early. They also likely lost the No. 1 seed in the NFC (need to win out and get help). Early week money is on Dallas and we agree as long as Hurts is out.

**Miami 24 CLEVELAND 17.** Whenever you see Miami traveling to the north this time of year, you immediately ask what is the weather forecast? As of Christmas morning it is going to be seasonably warm in Cleveland with a high of 52 degrees and likely rain showers. Obviously, Cleveland has been a huge disappointment and the Browns are just 4-11 ATS. Last week Dorian-Thompson-Robinson had a QBR of 18.3 in his first start. He is expected to start again here. Miami still has slim playoff hopes. The Dolphins have won 5 of their last 7 games and get another.

### Monday, December 30th

**Detroit 27 SAN FRANCISCO 23.** Entering the season, this looked like it could be one of the biggest games of the entire NFL season. A rematch of last year's thrilling NFC Championship game. The Lions have upheld their end with the most wins in franchise history. Meanwhile, the 49ers have already been eliminated from the playoffs. Despite a 6-9 SU and 5-10 ATS mark, San Francisco is No. 2 in ypp margin at +1.0, better than Detroit's +0.5 margin. However, Detroit will have revenge on their mind after blowing the 17-point lead last year. They also have much more to play for as they get the No. 1 seed if they win out. As of now, we don't expect to be involved here. We like the Lions but they are banged up.
