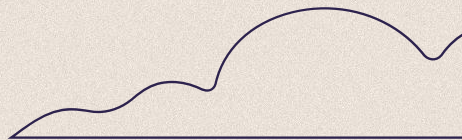
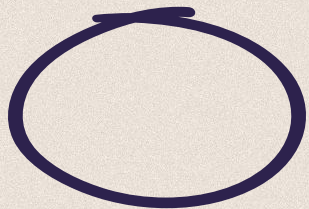

God has made us caretakers of the earth.

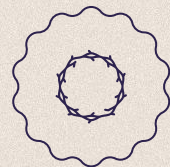
Lord, with our limited vocabulary and grateful hearts we honor You with our lips and worship You from the depths of our soul.

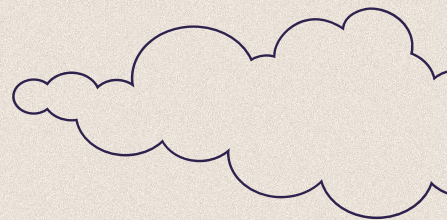

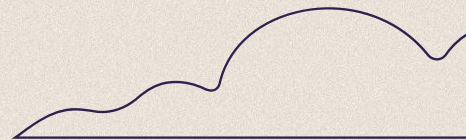

The Lord reigns forever; he has established his throne for judgment.

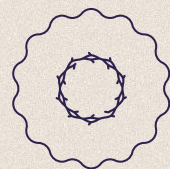
He rules the world in righteousness and judges the people with equity.
