Over the last year, we have worked with several successful grants and projects: Aggression Replacement Training and The Incredible Years at Steelton-Highspire School District, making guest services available on Airbnb at the Inn of Red Tomato Farm and the Family Check-Up Program. We continue to serve youth in Adams County with The Incredible Years Program reaching over 52 families and youth.

### LOOKING BACK AND LOOKING AHEAD

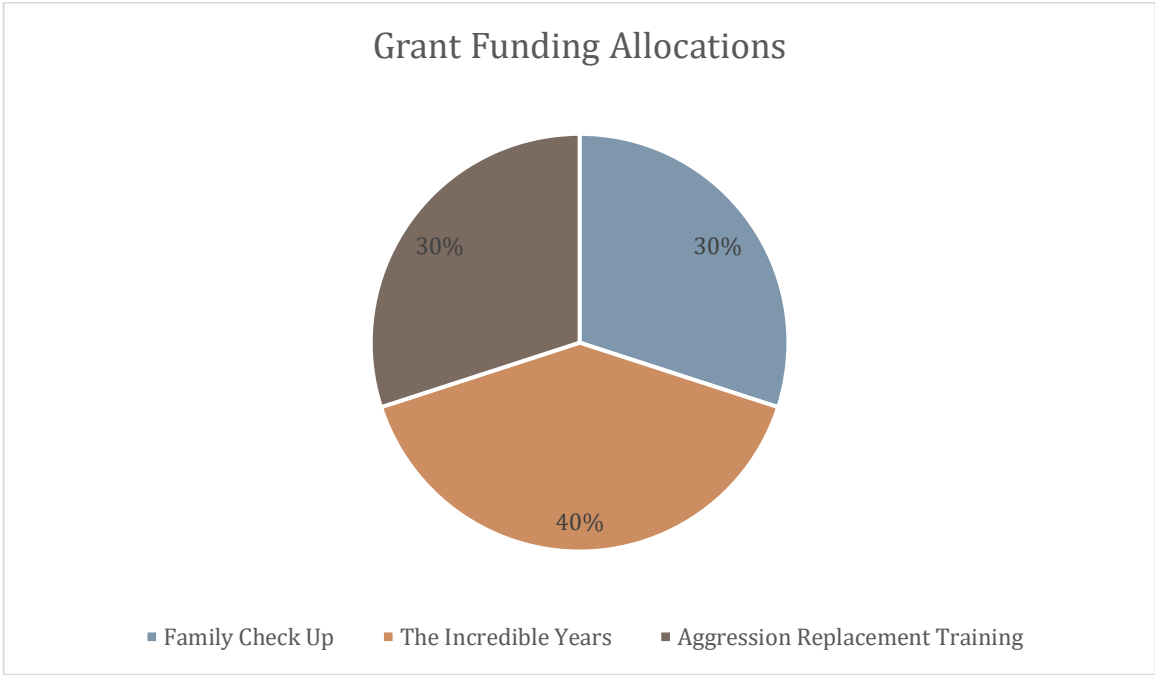
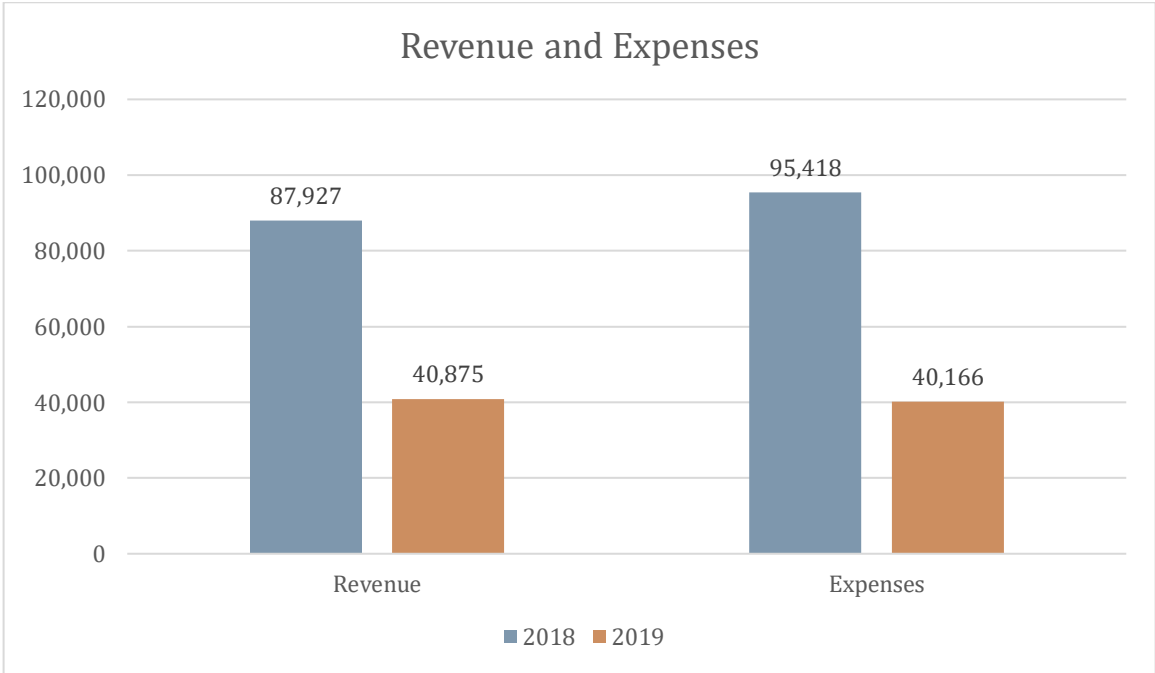

We have continued to honor my grandparents by adding the Family Check-Up and Everyday Parenting Programs as well as laying plans for our second farm operated by adults with disabilities. Our new location, Stone House Farm & Inn, will feature a farm to school initiative, teaching neighboring school children about nutrition, local food systems, and careers in agriculture. As we continue our work over the next decade, I plan like to expand the foundation laid by my grandparents to ensure continued growth for our non-profit while providing high quality programs to benefit families and youth in our communities.
