AN URDINANCE to protect wells for village water supply from pollution.

The Village of Dryden ordains:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful to leave, place, throw or cast out on any street, alley, park, public place or on any privately owned lands in the Village of Dryden within a radius of 200 feet from any well at any time used for supply of water to the Village of Dryden any carcass of any dead animal or person or any other deleterious or filthy material or any other substance whatever which would cause or be likely to cause any pollution to the water of such well.

Section 2: It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to construct or maintain within a radius of 200 feet of any well used as a source of water supply for the Village of Dryden any sewer, privy, cesspool, septic tank, leeching bed, barn yard, drain or any other structure to carry or hold sewerage or in which sewerage may be carried by the natural flow of water.

Section 3: Any person who shall violate or cause any act to be done which violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not to exceed ninety days or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court before which such person shall be adjudged guilty.

Section 4: All ordinances or resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions heretofore enacted which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5: This ordinance shall take effect on the 15th day of March, 1945.
