

### Pastor's Cause to Pause

Acts 1:1 "In the first book, Theophilus, I wrote about all that Jesus did and taught from the beginning" Acts 2:1

When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. <sup>2</sup> And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. <sup>3</sup> Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them. <sup>4</sup> All of them were filled with

the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability.

Jesus's birth on Christmas Day is to the Holy Spirit on Pentecost. Pentecost falls on the 50<sup>th</sup> day after Easter Day. So, on June 9, the church will celebrate the Holy Spirit being breathed into God's people. On Pentecost, we will read from the book of Acts and then for the 24 Sundays which follow Pentecost Sunday, the gospel readings will be read from the Gospel of Luke. It is believed that Luke is the writer of Luke and that Acts is the second volume of Luke's writings. Luke seems to have a deeper understanding, maybe a reality, with the Holy Spirit, which the other gospel writers don't speak of in their gospels. Luke writes that, *Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit (Luke 1:41)* and *Zechariah was filled with the Holy Spirit (Luke 1:67)*. Simeon was told that the Holy Spirit <u>rested</u> upon him and that later the Holy Spirit would <u>reveal</u> to him. (*Luke 2:25-27*)

Luke understand the Holy Spirit to be given by God to God's people. *If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!" (Luke 11:13)* 

Pentecost is the day we celebrate the giving of the Holy Spirit to God's people. The Spirit blows among the people of Mt. Hermon. We can feel it! We can feel God calling us to be better disciples than we already are. God is calling us to something incredible.

Come to worship. Invite others to come with you. Come and have your "hair windblown by the Spirit!"

It was suggested that those in your Care groups who have not signed up be contacted and encouraged to participate in one of these.

**ADOPTION OF AGENDA:** The agenda for May was adopted with the following addition under New Business: Skyler Miller Eagle Scout project

**ADOPTION OF MINUTES:** The minutes for the April council meeting were accepted. **REPORTS:** 

Pastor Gina- report received for May. Treasurer- No report due to Emily's absence Financial Secretary- report received for April.

#### Team Report/Recommendations:

- 1. Worship Team: Report received for May meeting. Discussion held about the need for a "Head" usher. Worship Team looking into this position, duties, etc.
  - a. **Recommendation**: The Worship and Music Team recommends that we purchase two 3'x6' banners from Paper Pro, Inc. to be placed on our front lawn to advertise our Memorial Day Service at a cost of \$270 and to be paid from the Mt. Hermon Fund for the Arts. **Passed** (it was clarified that these signs do not include data, so will be re-usable)
  - b. **Recommendation:** The Worship and Music Team recommends that we begin a Candlelight Dinner Series with donations/contributions to fund the Mt. Hermon Fund for the Arts. **Passed**
- 2. Care Team: A member has asked that we re-instate the Food and Fellowship time between Worship and Sunday school. Will go to Care Team for discussion.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

- 1. Farming Church: Listening groups are going well.
- 2. Cemetery: Finance committee reviewing quotes.
- 3. Safety Committee: Herb is reviewing information.
- 4. Parsonage Task Force: Information is ready to present to the congregation. A congregational meeting will be held to present these options.
- 5. Synod Assembly: Pastor Gina, Terry Swygert, and Rebekah Swygert will attend.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- 1. Treasurer transition/election: Emily Morris needs to resign from this position. Parker Boulware was elected. He and Emily will work out the transition.
- 2. Toby's Place collection: Brayden Rutherford has asked that he collect money for this project. **Passed**
- 3. Newsletter mail-out: Newsletter will now be mailed out to everyone with bulk mail. This is cheaper than the select mailing we were currently doing, and many members were being missed.
- 4. Skyler Miller Eagle Project: Skyler Miller has asked permission for him to move forward with plans to build a picnic shelter on church property. This will be located near the fire pit. He will bring back final plans to the council before beginning construction. **Passed**
- 5. Due to several members being absent, next meeting will be held June 2 after the congregational meeting.

After Feedback, the meeting was adjourned with praying the Lord's Prayer.
